

## CASH ASSISTANCE DRUG CONVICTION SANCTION AGREEMENT

### END FOR CA DRUG CONVICTION SANCTION

The person who is convicted August 9, 2017 or later, agrees to random drug testing and meets at least one of the following criteria:

1. Successfully completes, or is accepted into, a substance abuse treatment program.  
The person also meets this criteria if they are:
  - a. Currently accepted for treatment in a substance abuse treatment program, but is on a waiting list.  
The person remains enrolled in the treatment program and enters the treatment program at the first available opportunity.
  - b. Currently accepted for treatment, and is participating in a substance abuse treatment program.
  
2. Is determined by a licensed medical provider to not need substance abuse treatment.
  
3. If applicable, is in compliance with all terms of probation related to the conviction they were sanctioned for.

The person convicted of the felony drug conviction will be permanently disqualified. Once the minimum sanction period has been imposed, the benefits will be returned to the total eligible benefit amount for the remaining household members.
