**MEDALLION PROGRAM**



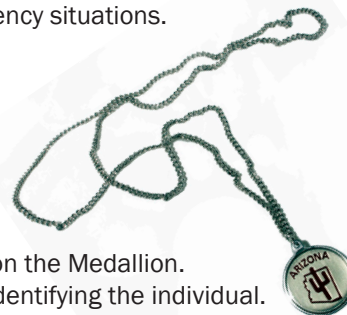
The purpose of the Medallion Program is to provide for individual safety and protection during emergencies. The Medallion gives First Responders a 24-hour phone number to call. This helps to assist people during emergency situations.

**Key Features:**

- Available to all members of the Division of Developmental Disabilities.
- There is no cost for the program.
- Members receive a medallion as a bracelet, shoe tag or necklace.

**How it works:**

- The Medallion contains a 24-hour hotline number and a unique case number.
- During an emergency, First Responders will call the 24-hour hotline number listed on the Medallion.
- The hotline operator will provide information to First Responders, to help assist in identifying the individual.
