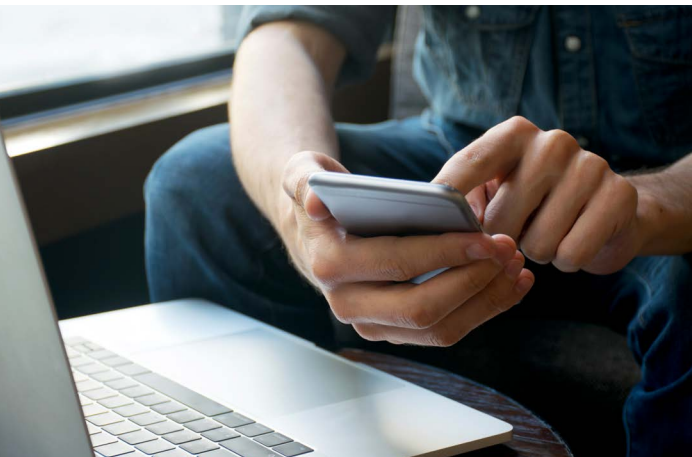

Trade Adjustment Assistance (TAA)

TAA provides intensive reemployment and case management services to workers who are laid off or threatened with layoff due to foreign competition or outsourcing of jobs to another country.

TAA assists trade affected workers by helping them return to suitable employment as quickly as possible.

TAA is operated by the Department of Labor Employment and Training Administration and administered by the Arizona Department of Economic Security.



Workers Eligible for TAA May Qualify to Receive:

- Employment and Case Management Services with opportunities to obtain the skills, credentials, resources and support necessary to become reemployed
- Classroom Training, Customized Training, On-the-Job Training, Apprenticeship programs and more
- Basic Education Instruction (including Literacy and English as a Second Language)
- Job Search Allowance
- Relocation Allowance
- Transportation Allowance
- Trade Readjustment Allowances (income support) for workers enrolled in fulltime training
- Reemployment TAA (RTAA) Wage Subsidy for Older Workers
