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WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR VR SERVICES?

Eligible individuals must:

- Have a documented physical or mental impairment that results in a substantial impediment to employment;
- Require VR services to prepare for, secure, retain, or regain employment; and
- Be able to benefit from the provision of VR services in terms of achieving an employment outcome.

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WHAT IS THE VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION PROGRAM?

Vocational Rehabilitation is a work program that provides a variety of services to assist individuals who have disabilities with preparing for, entering into, retaining, or regaining employment.

WHAT ARE THE VR SERVICES AN ELIGIBLE INDIVIDUAL MAY RECEIVE?

Based on individual needs and informed choice, eligible individuals may receive the following types of services:

- Vocational counseling and help in creating a job goal
- Evaluations to determine job skills and interests
- Assistance with training or education, if needed to obtain a job
- Help with job interview skills
- Special equipment or technology that is needed for the job
- Assistance with getting to training, services, or job site
