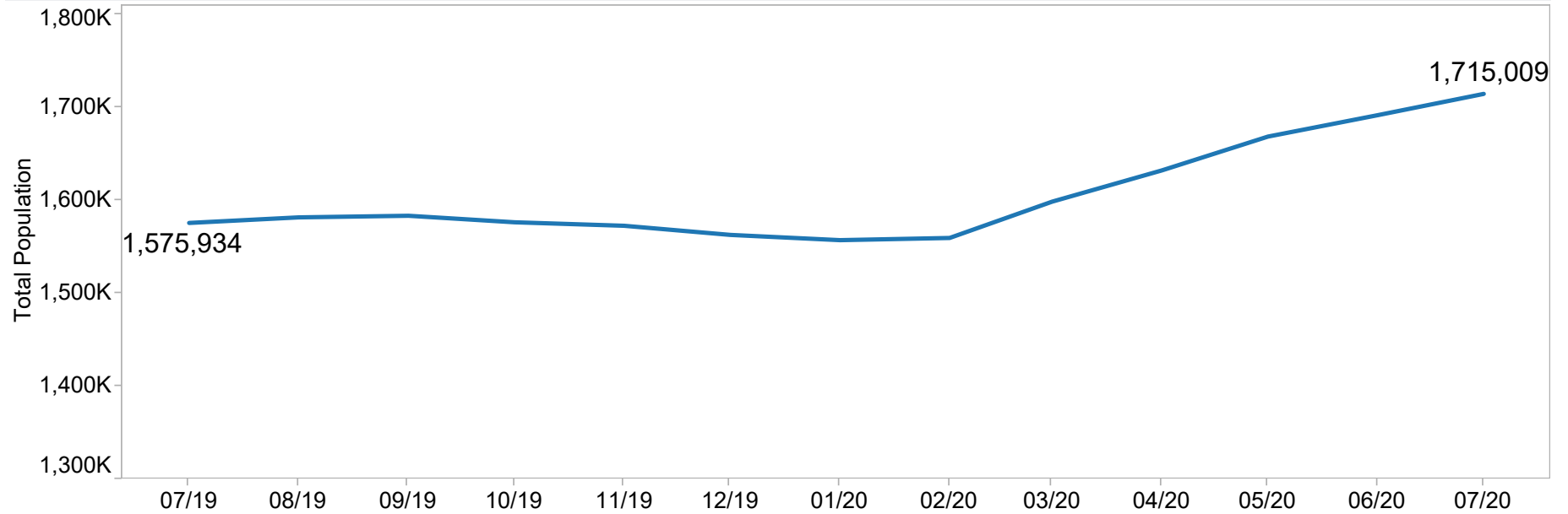

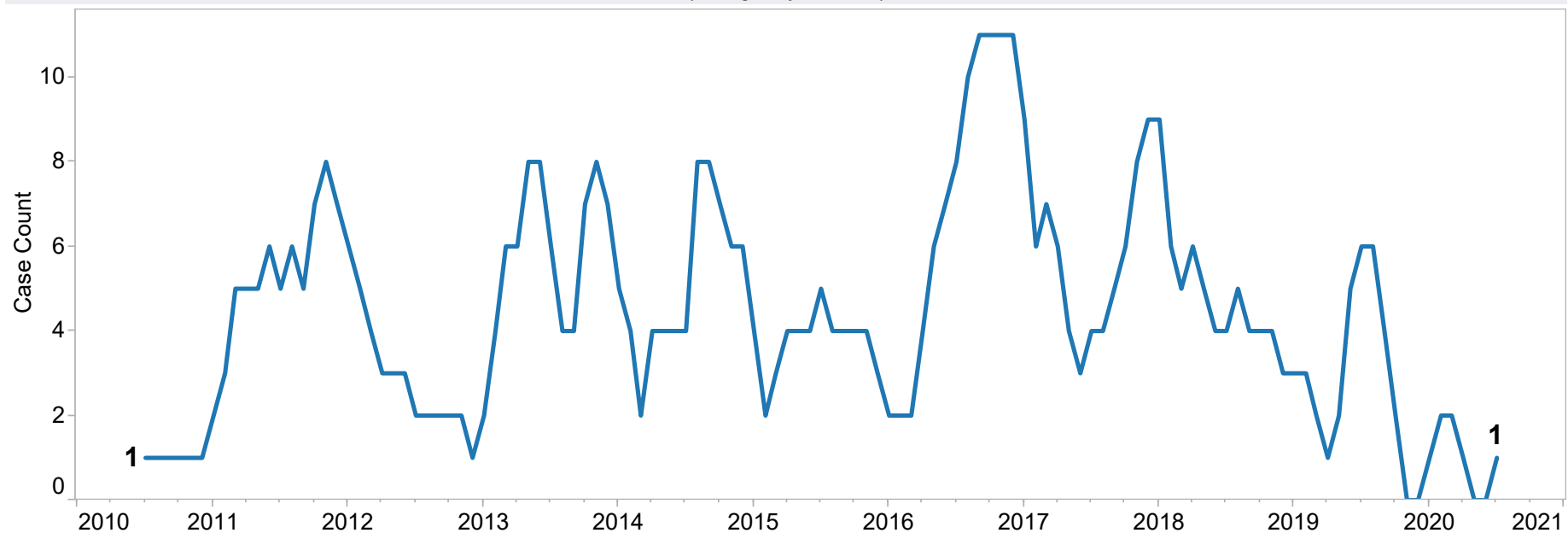

### 1 Year Sparkline Population Trend

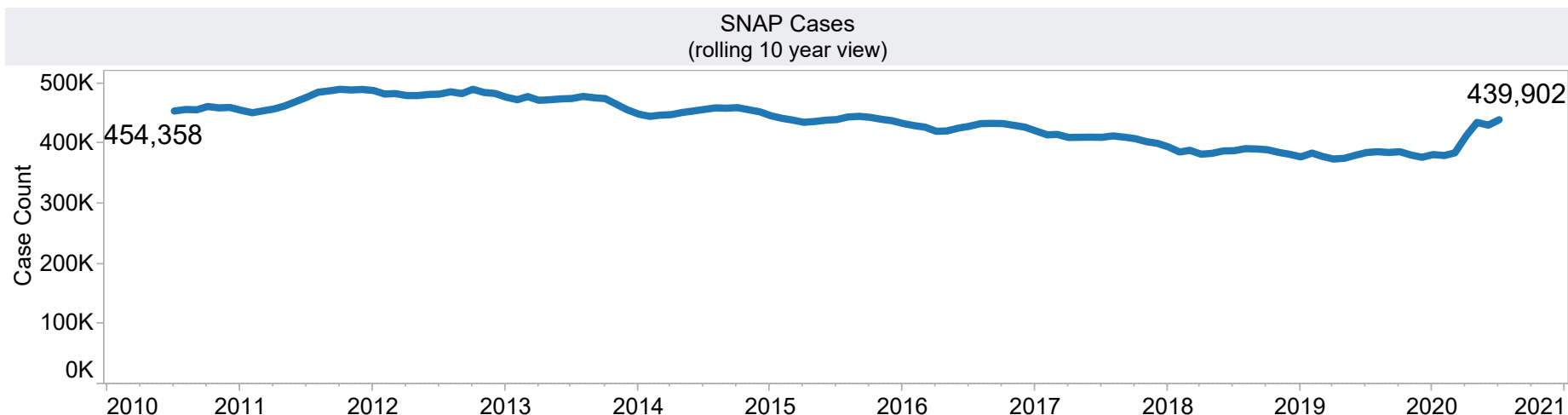


### Tuberculosis Control (rolling 10 year view)

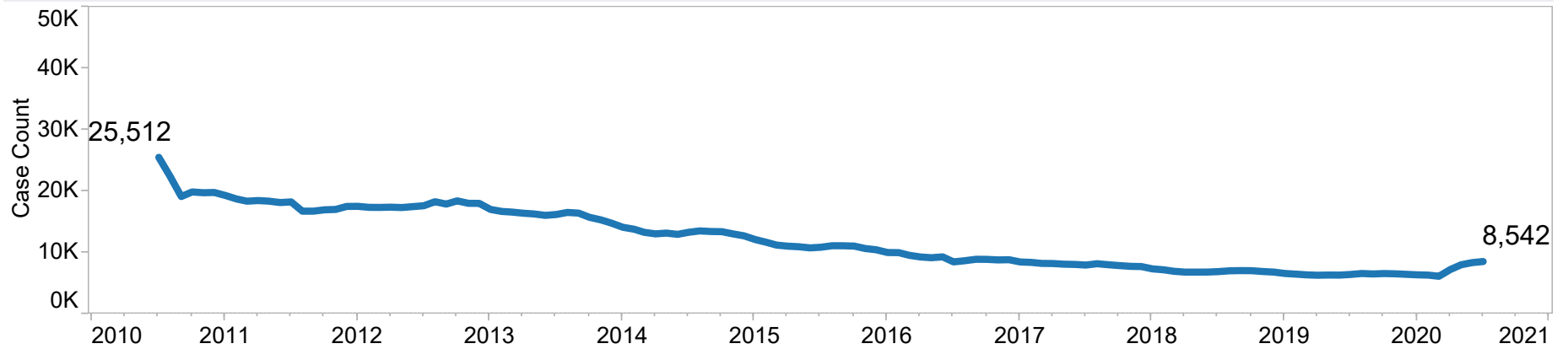
