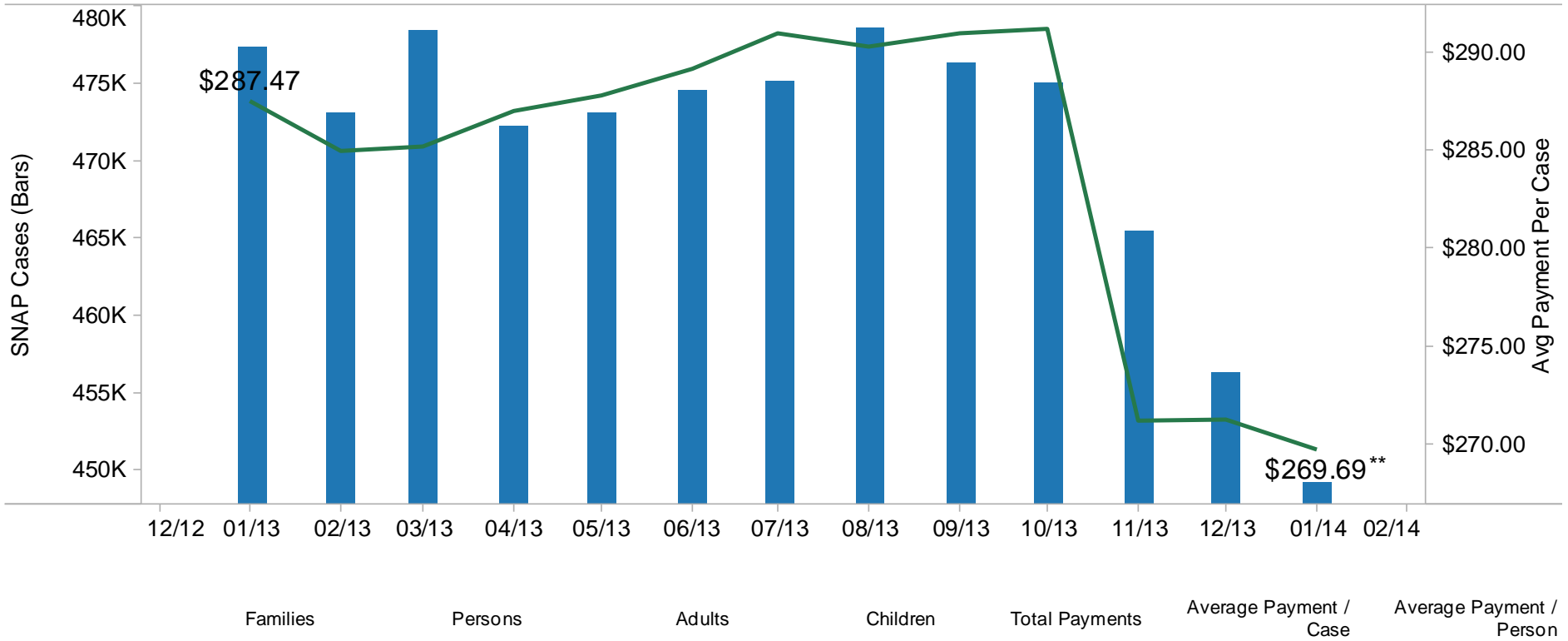

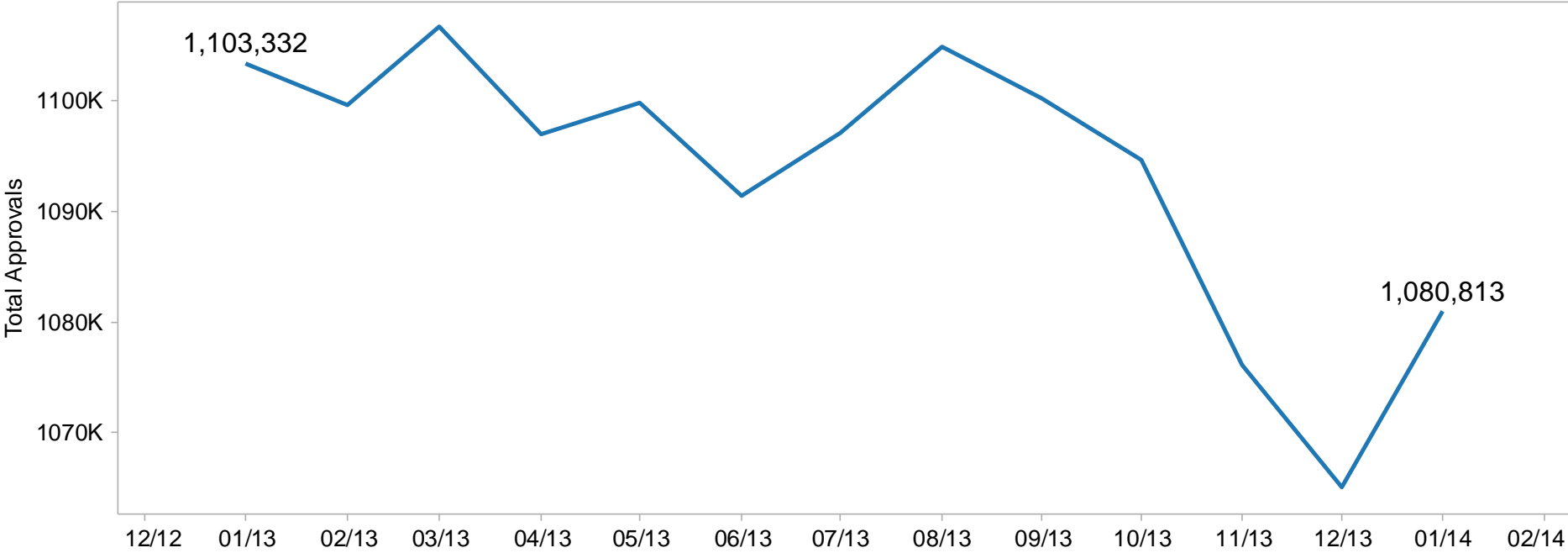

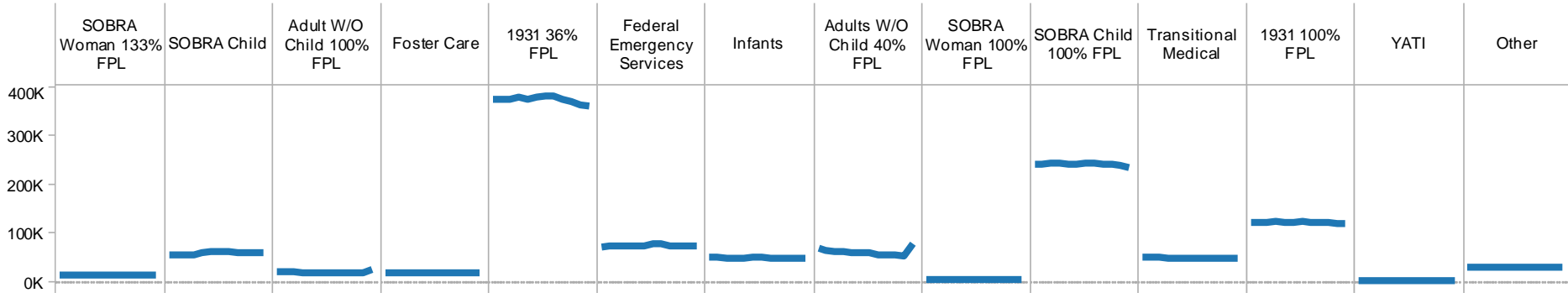

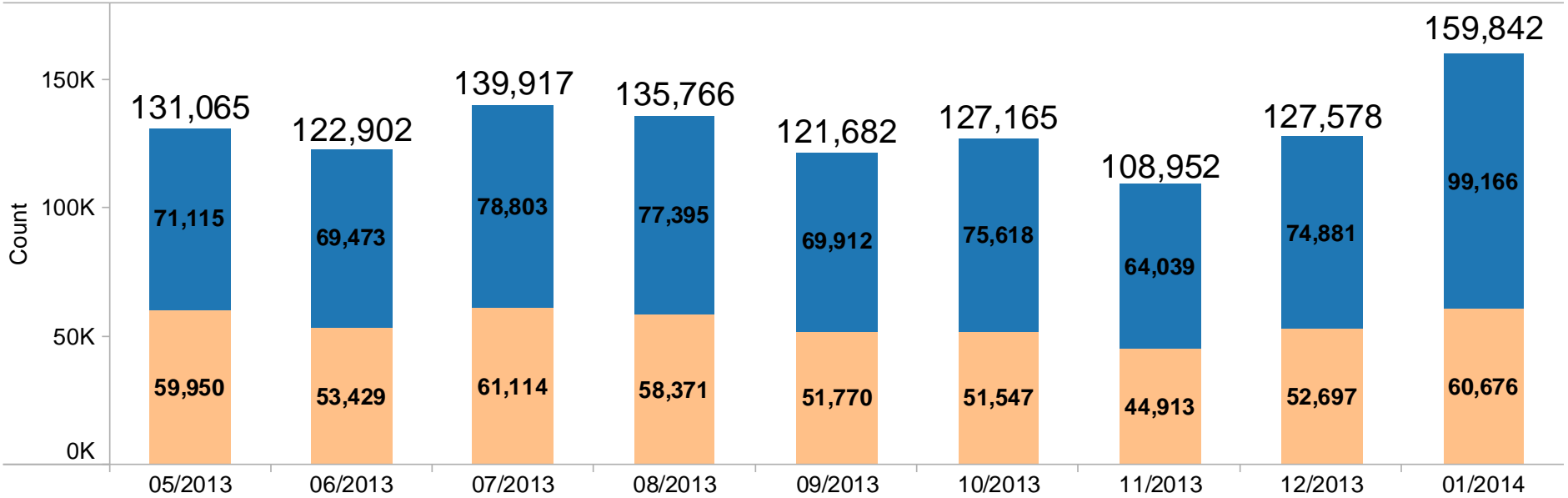

1 Year Sparkline Trend

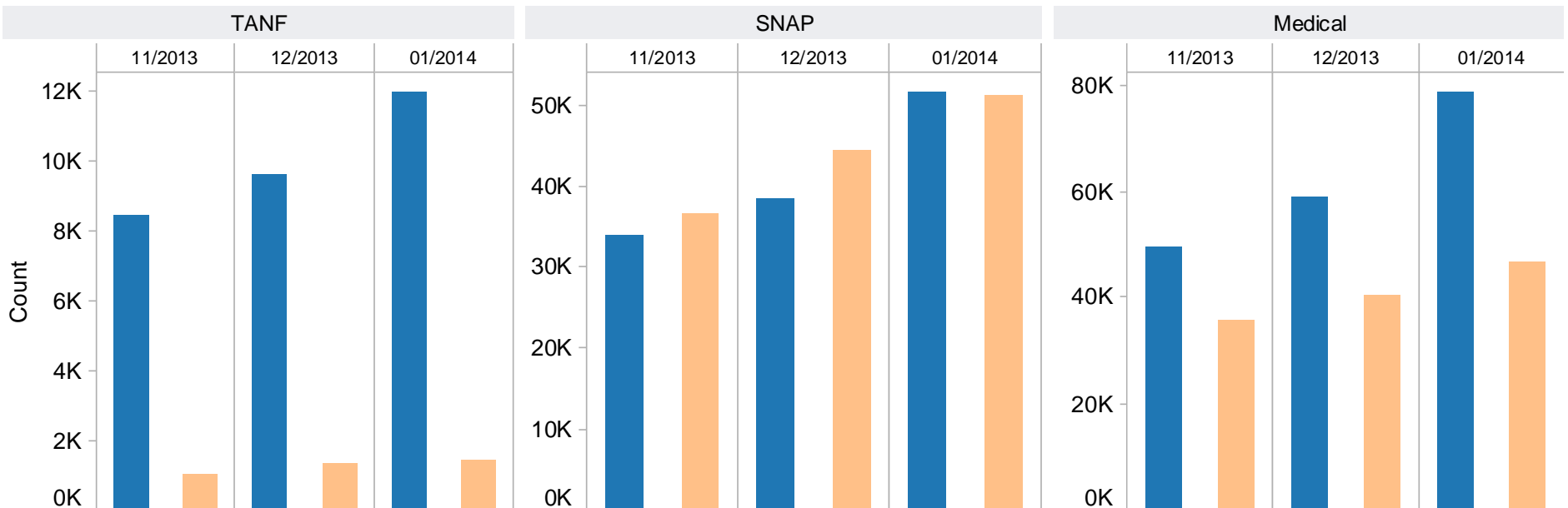

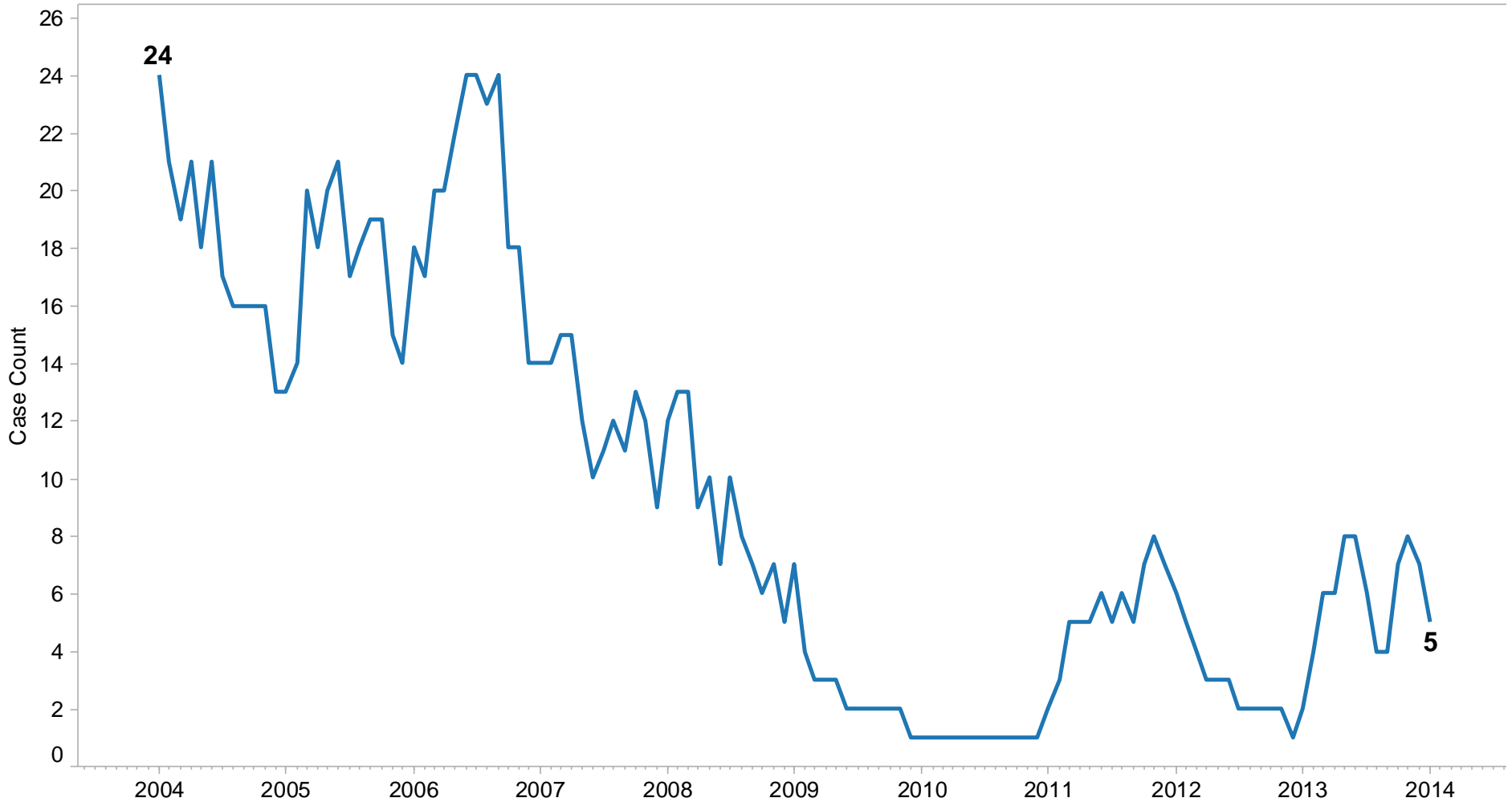
Dark Blue - Initial applications, includes applicants applying for the first time or had a break in benefits

Applications by Program



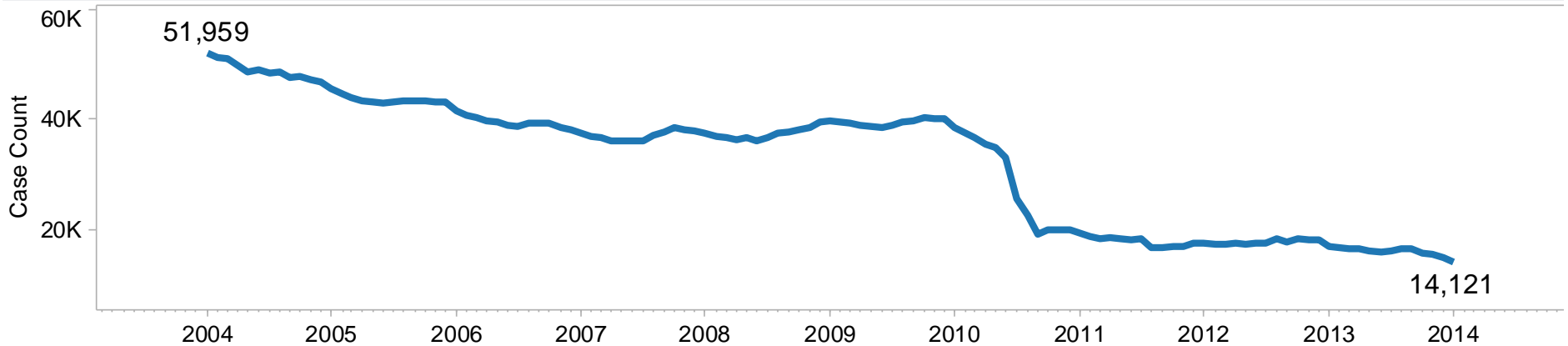
Tuberculosis Control

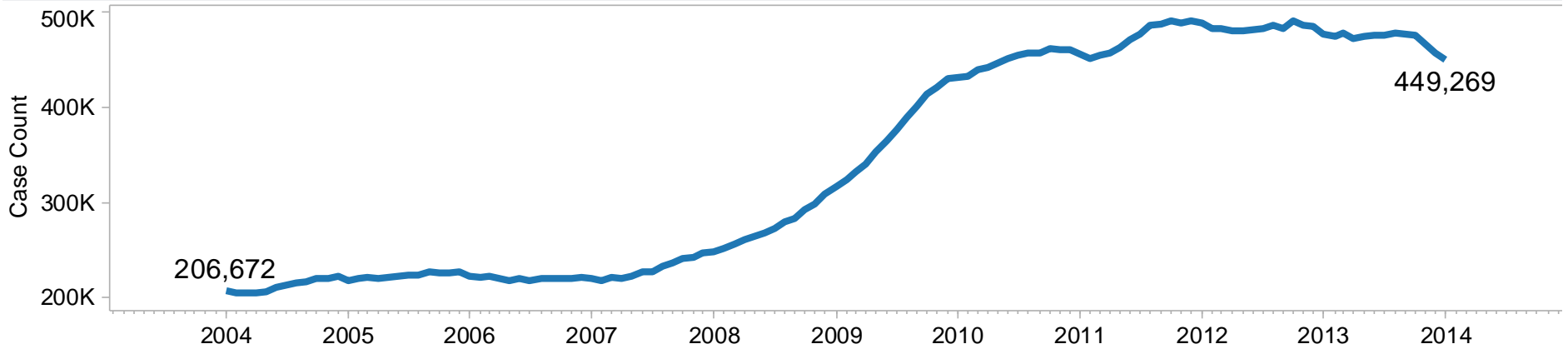
TANF Cases

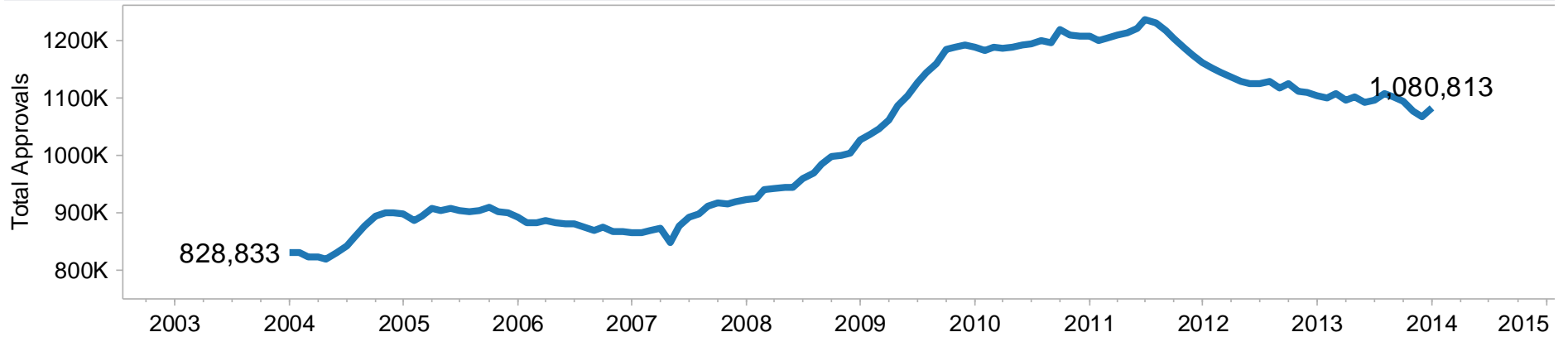
SNAP Cases
