

## IMPORTANT LABOR DISPUTE INFORMATION

*If you are unemployed because of a labor dispute, the following information is for you.*

### WHAT YOU MUST DO

- File an initial claim as instructed.
- READ the information below BEFORE you designate a representative on the Labor Dispute Information form (LDU-1003A).

### WHAT IT MEANS IF YOU CHECK:

My Union

- Your union will receive a copy of the labor dispute determination; **you will not**.
- You will delegate to your union the responsibility for the filing of an appeal if the determination is not in your favor.
- Your union will get a copy of the appeal decision; **you will not**.
- You must contact your union for information regarding the determination and/or the appeal.

Myself

- You will receive a copy of the labor dispute determination.
- You will be responsible for filing any appeal of the determination if it is not in your favor.
- You must represent yourself at any appeal hearing.
- You will receive a copy of the appeal decision.

Other

- This person will receive the labor dispute determination; **you will not**.
- You will delegate this person the responsibility of the filing of an appeal if the determination is not in your favor.
- You will delegate to this person the responsibility of representing you at any appeal hearing.
- This person will receive a copy of the appeal decision; **you will not**.

### WHAT HAPPENS AFTER YOU FILE YOUR CLAIM

- The labor dispute unit of this agency will request information from your employer and from your union.
- The labor dispute unit will then use all available information to issue a determination which will indicate who is eligible for benefits and who is not. This will often take several weeks.
- Normally, no claims will be released until the labor dispute determination is issued, at which time eligible claims will be paid.
- You will be expected to meet the eligibility requirements as explained in the booklet, *A Guide to Arizona Unemployment Insurance Benefits* (UIB-1240A), **except** that you do not have to register with Employment Service, and you will not be required to look for work **AS LONG AS THE LABOR DISPUTE EXISTS**.
- During this time, all work which you perform or earnings which you receive must be reported. **THIS INCLUDES WORK OR EARNINGS FROM PICKET LINE DUTY.**
