What is the Hilton Honors Military Program?

Am I Eligible for the Hilton Honors Military Program?

To be eligible for the Hilton Honors Military Program, a person must:

- ★ Served in the US Armed Forces for at least 180 days and was discharged or released under conditions other than dishonorable. Active service includes full-time duty in the National Guard or a Reserve component.
- ★ Be a resident of or reside in Arizona or moving to Arizona from a state that does not offer the Hilton Honors program.
- ★ Provide a copy of a valid DD214 or if on active duty a copy of active military ID card
- ★ Complete a full registration in www.azjobconnection.gov
- ★ Have active job search activity and is “work ready”.
- ★ Be required to travel over 50 miles from his or her current residence to participate in an employment activity.
- ★ Create a Hilton Honors account at JoinHonors.com
- ★ Have a valid e-mail address.
