Workers eligible for Trade Adjustment Assistance (TAA) may receive some of the following benefits and services:

- ✓ Reemployment services
- ✓ Employment counseling
- ✓ Career assessment and development
- ✓ Approved education and training including:
 - ◆ Classroom training
 - ◆ On-the-job training
 - ◆ Customized training
 - ◆ Registered apprenticeship
 - ◆ Basic/Remedial instruction (including literacy and English as a Second Language)
 - ◆ Credentials/Certifications
- ✓ Supportive Services:
Connections to additional resources
- ✓ Job Search Allowance:
Costs incurred during a job search outside your local area
- ✓ Relocation Allowance:
Costs incurred in relocating for a job outside your local area

- ✓ Trade Readjustment Allowances (TRA):
Weekly benefits paid to eligible workers enrolled in full-time training
- ✓ Transportation/Subsistence Allowances:
Costs incurred while attending training outside the local area
- ✓ Reemployment Trade Adjustment Assistance (RTAA) specifically for workers age 50 and older.
- ✓ Health Coverage Tax Credit (HCTC):
Tax credits to support qualifying health insurance premiums
