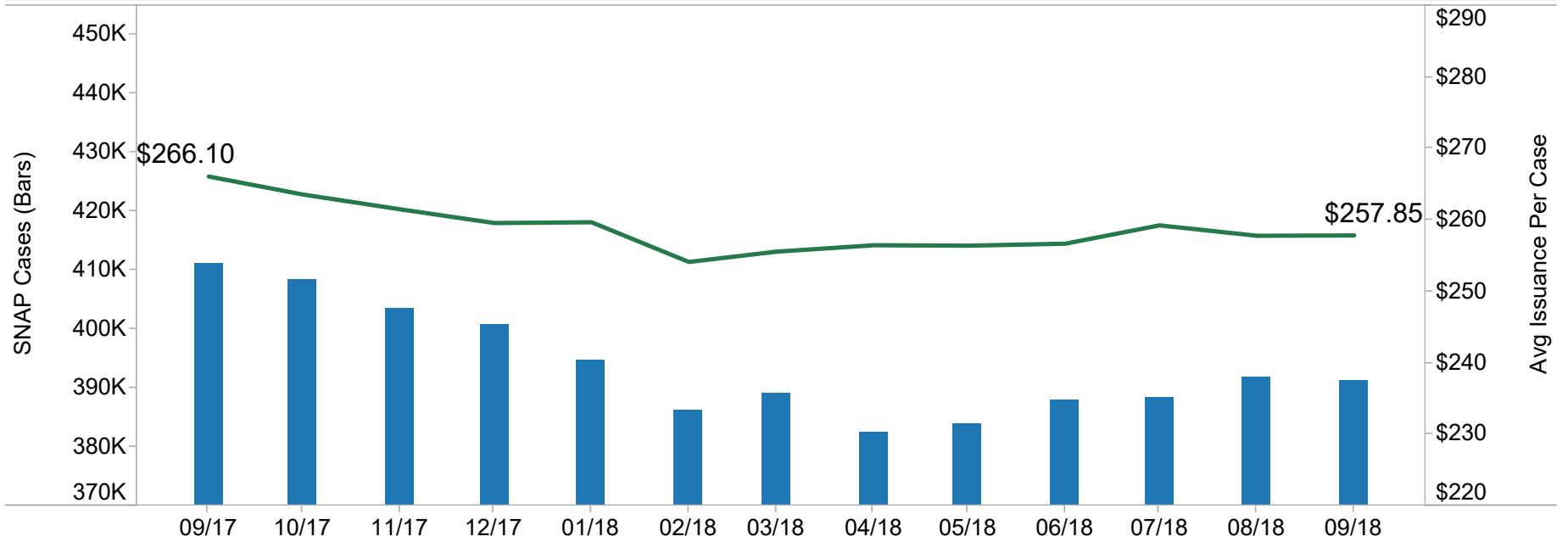

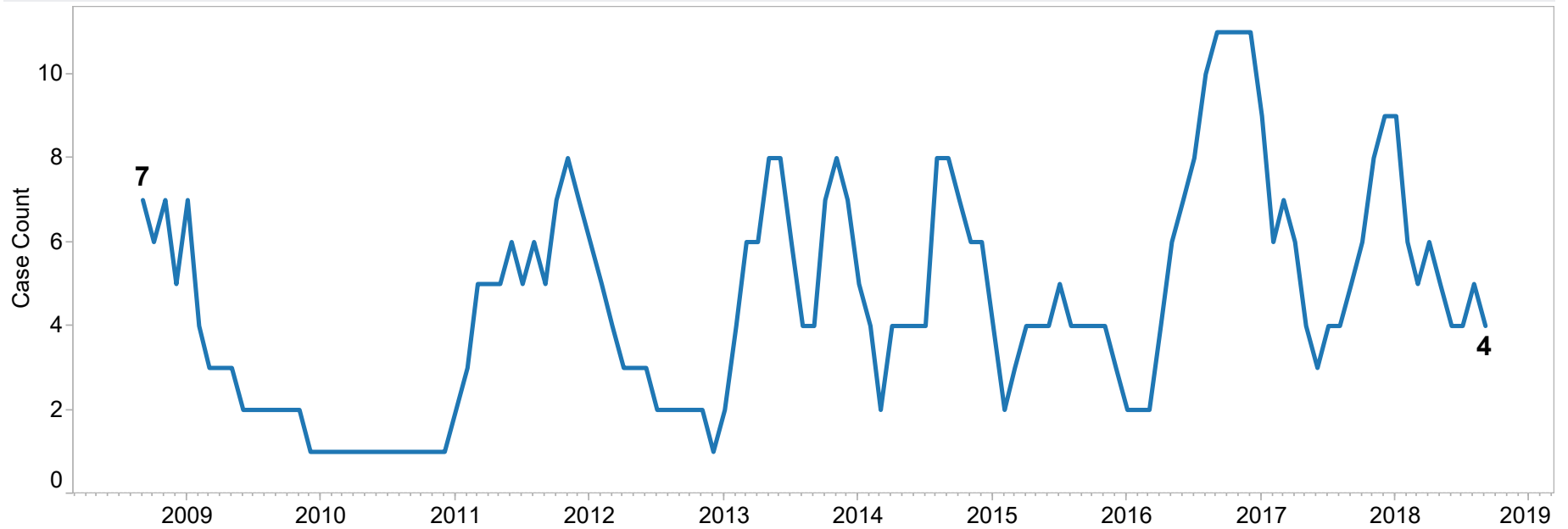

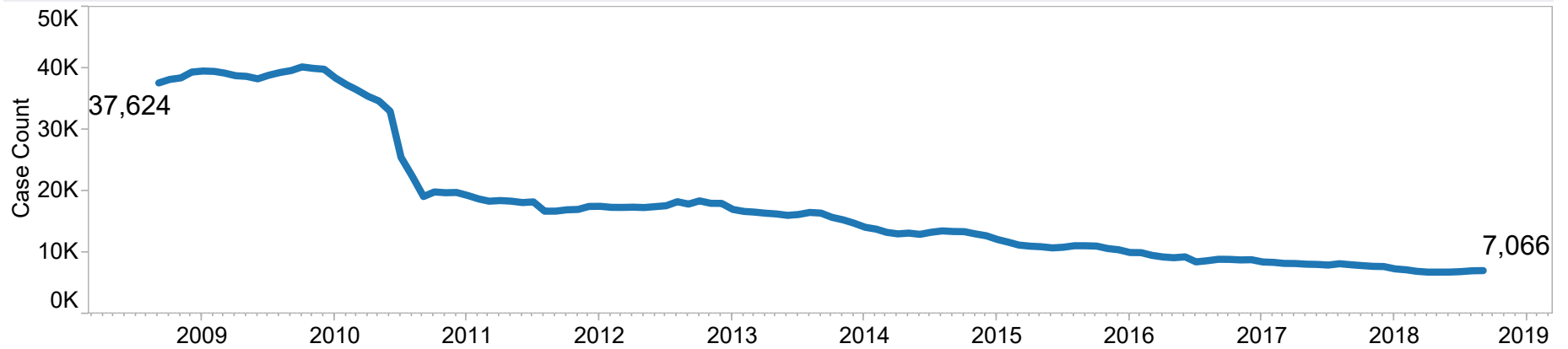
Tuberculosis Control

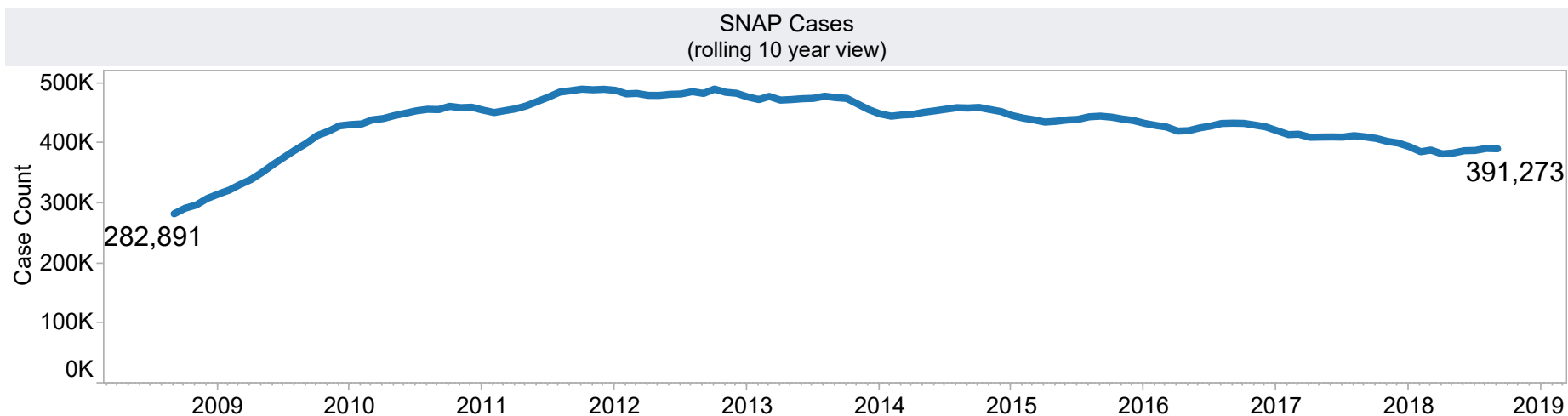
