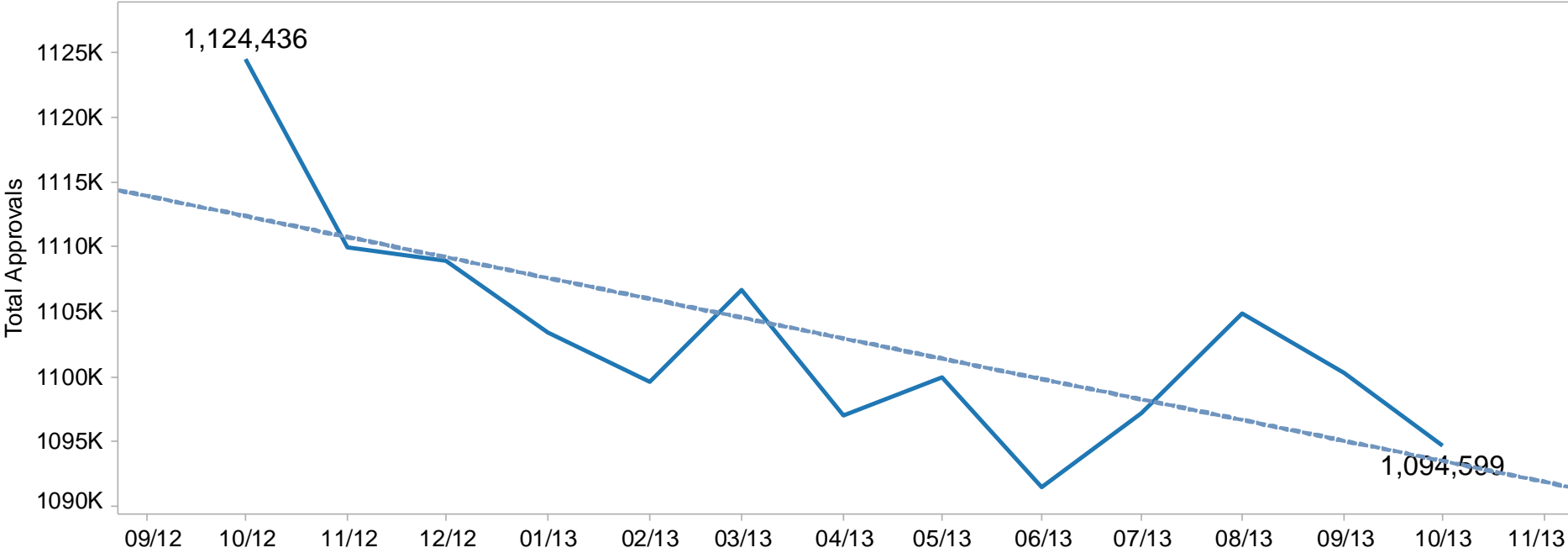

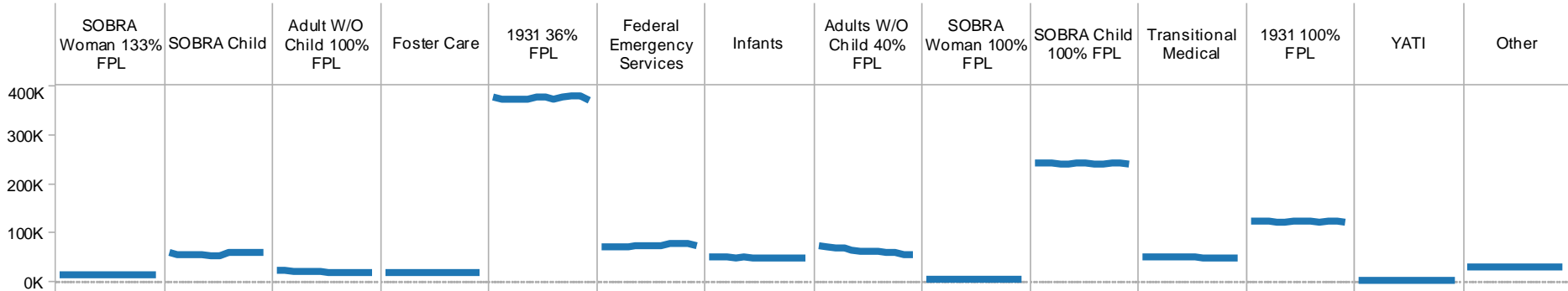

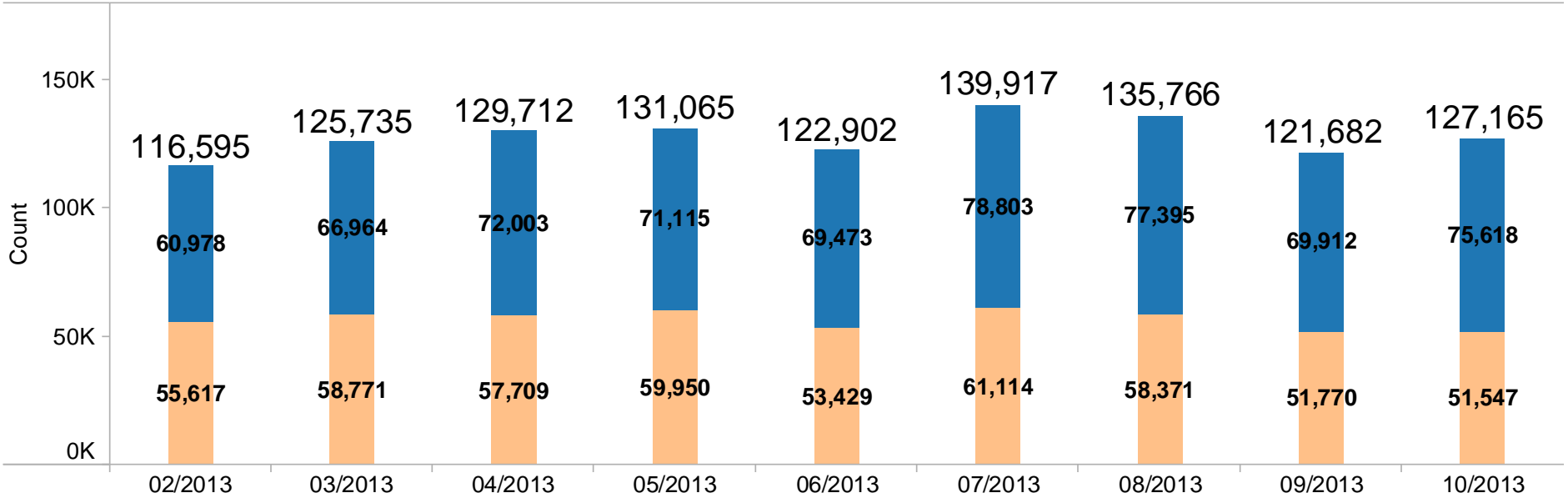

### 1 Year Sparkline Trend

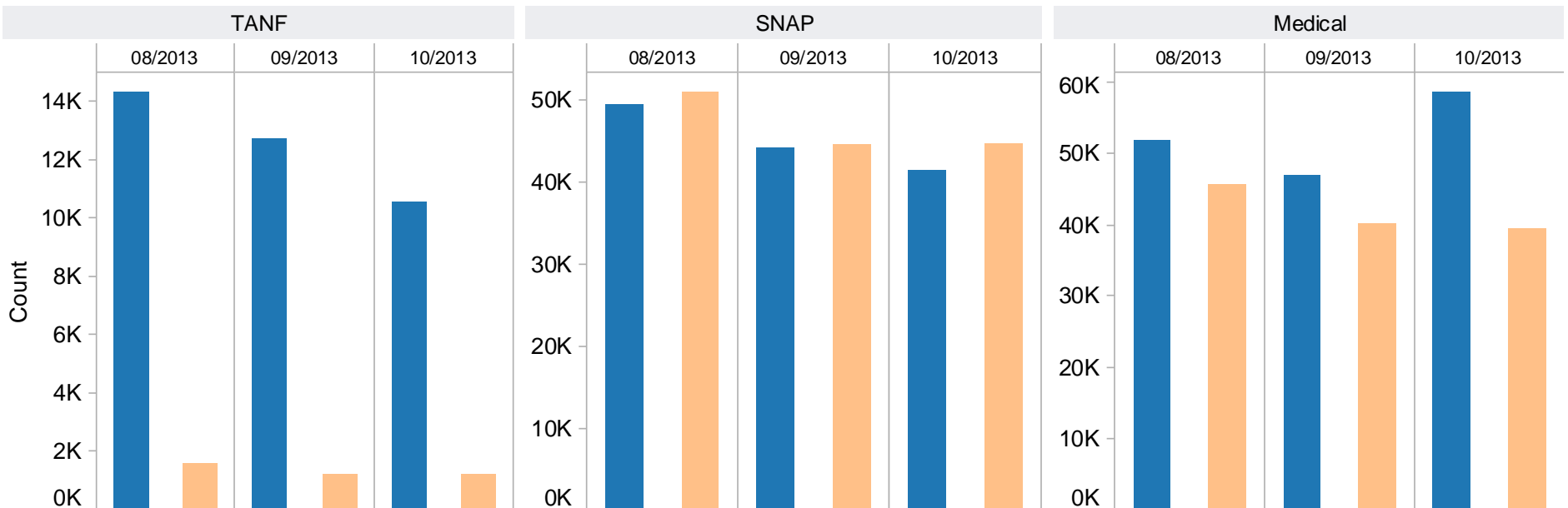

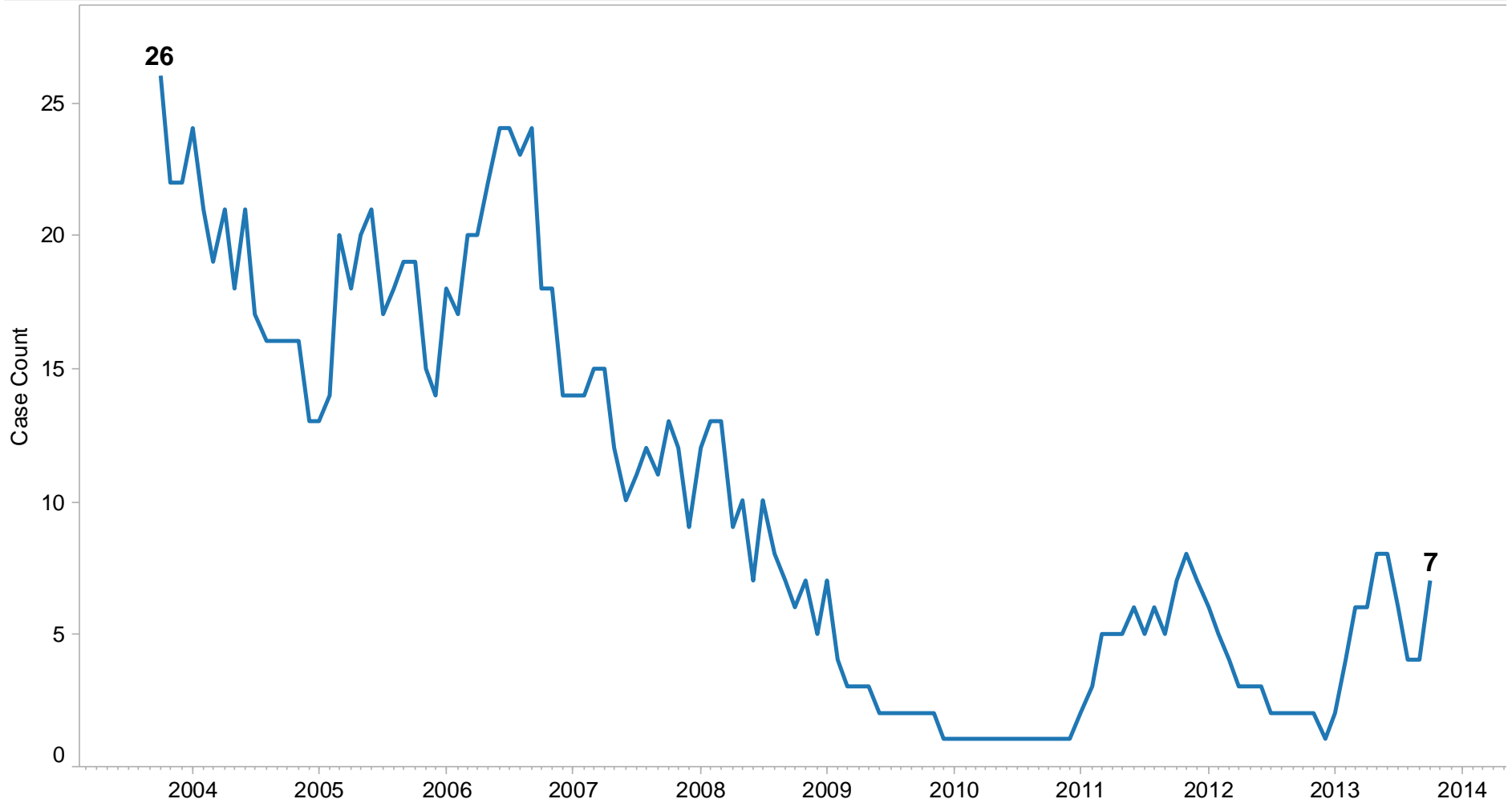

### Applications by Program



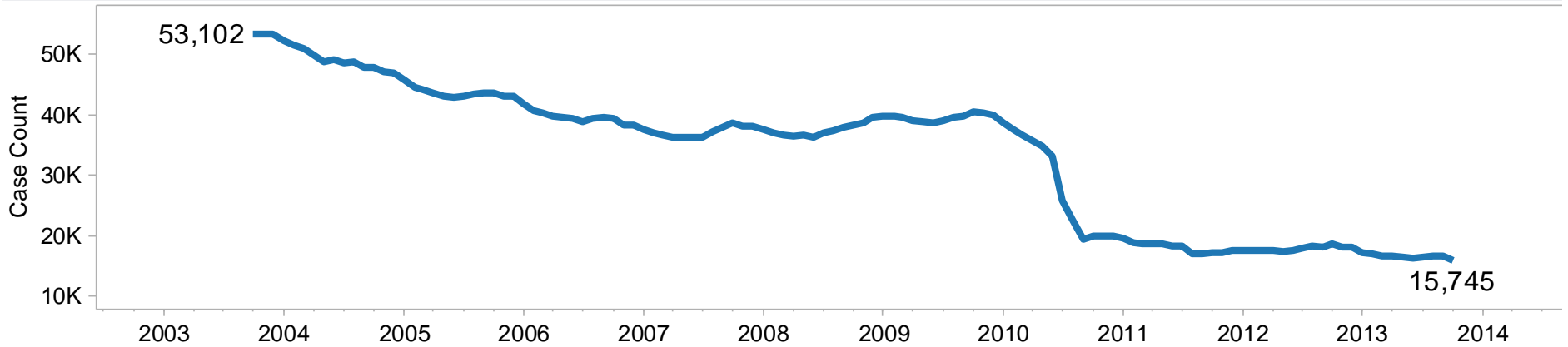
Tuberculosis Control

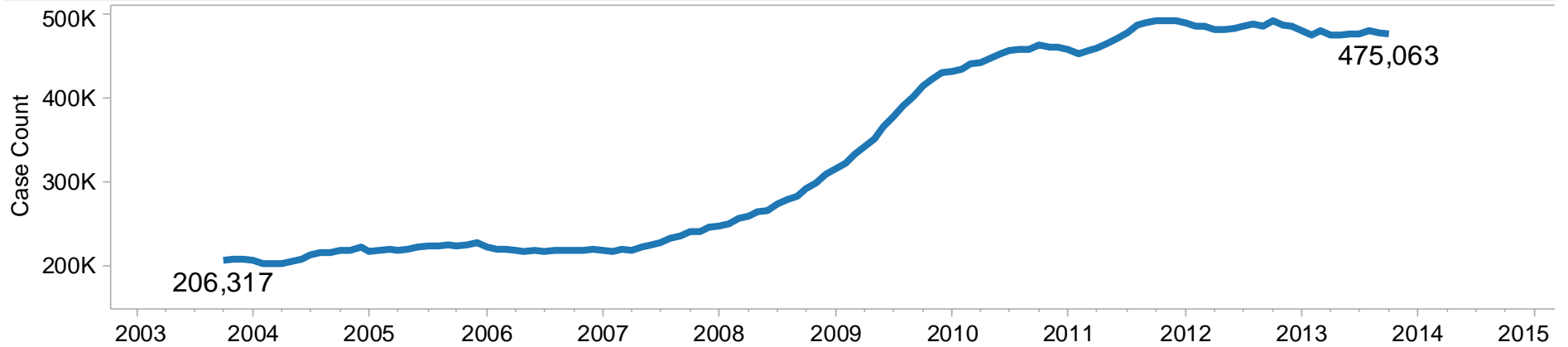

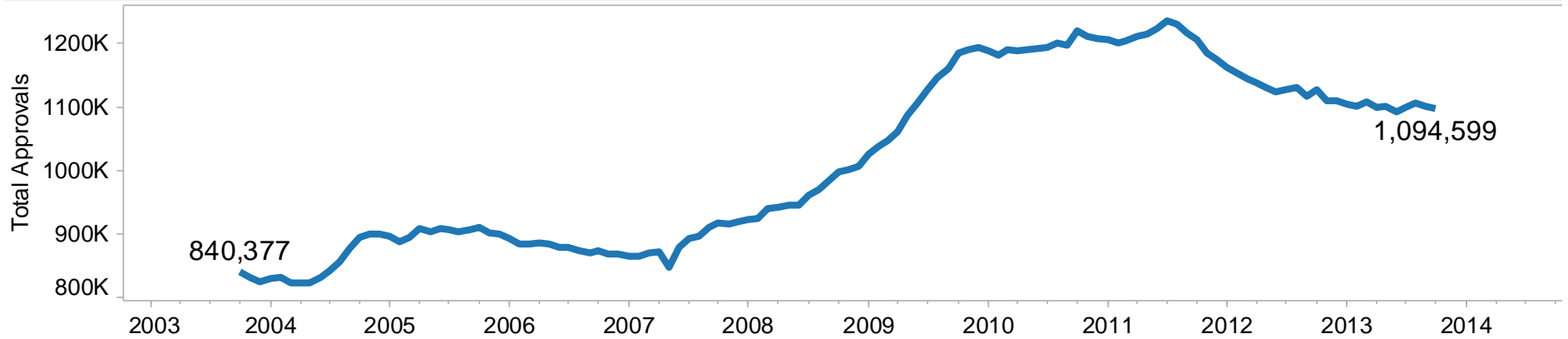
