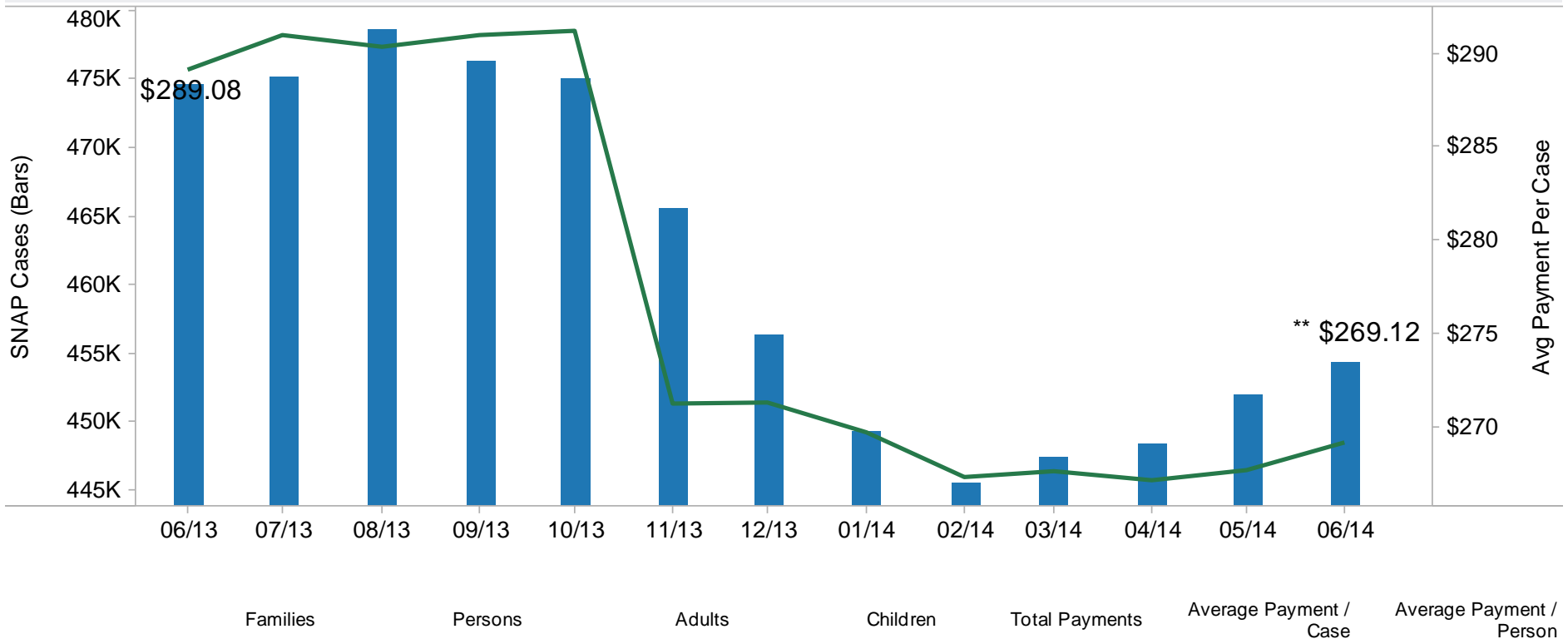

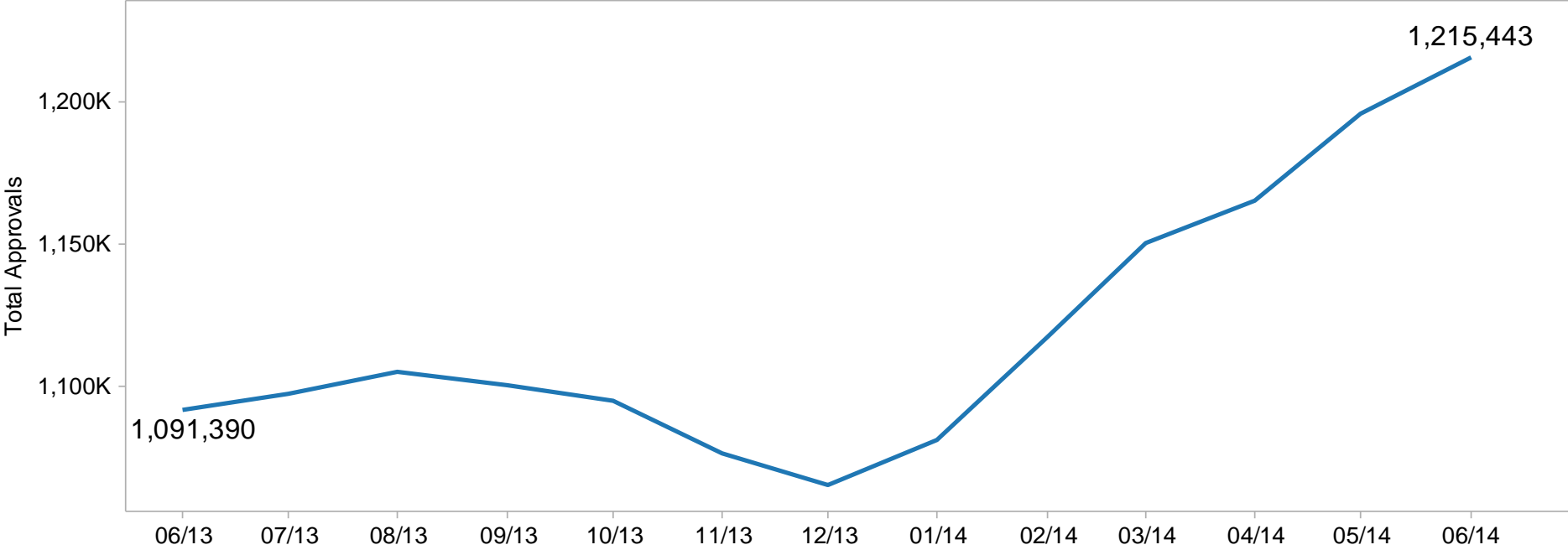

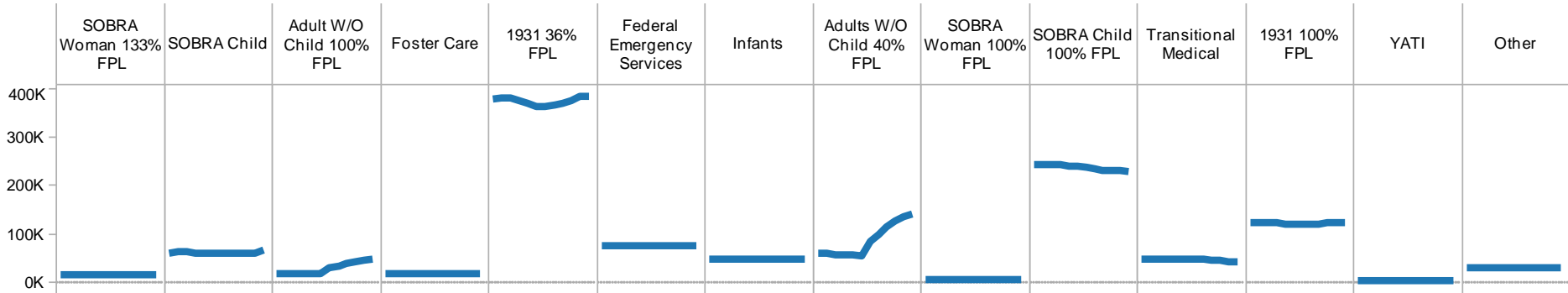

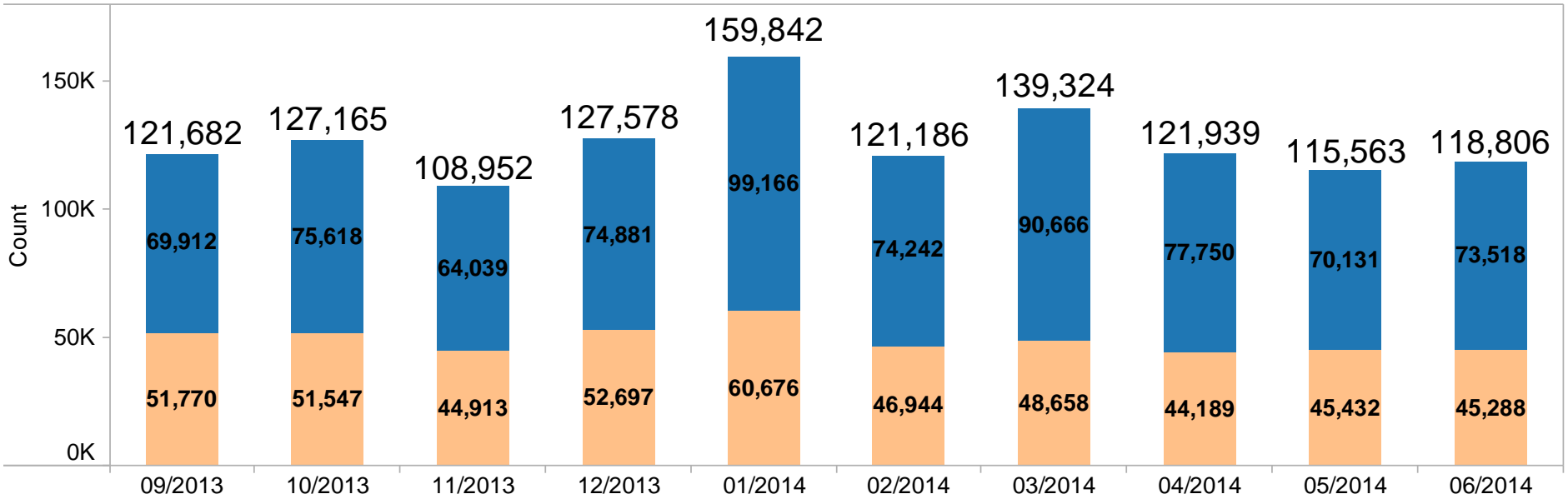

1 Year Sparkline Trend

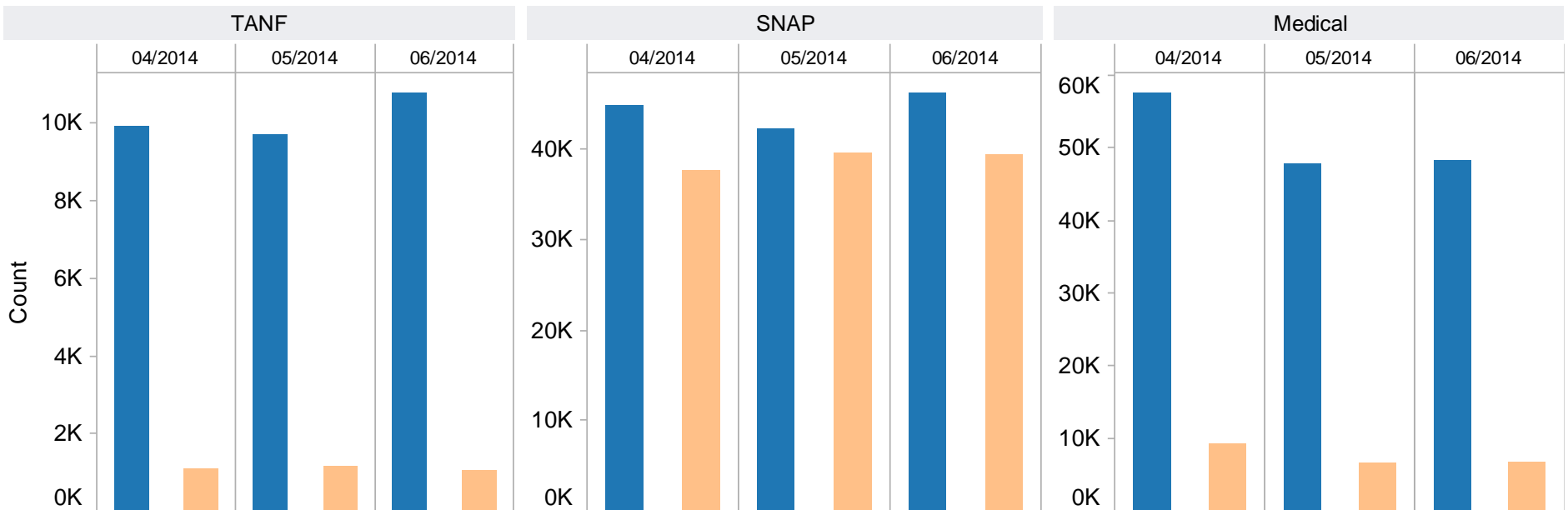

Applications by Program



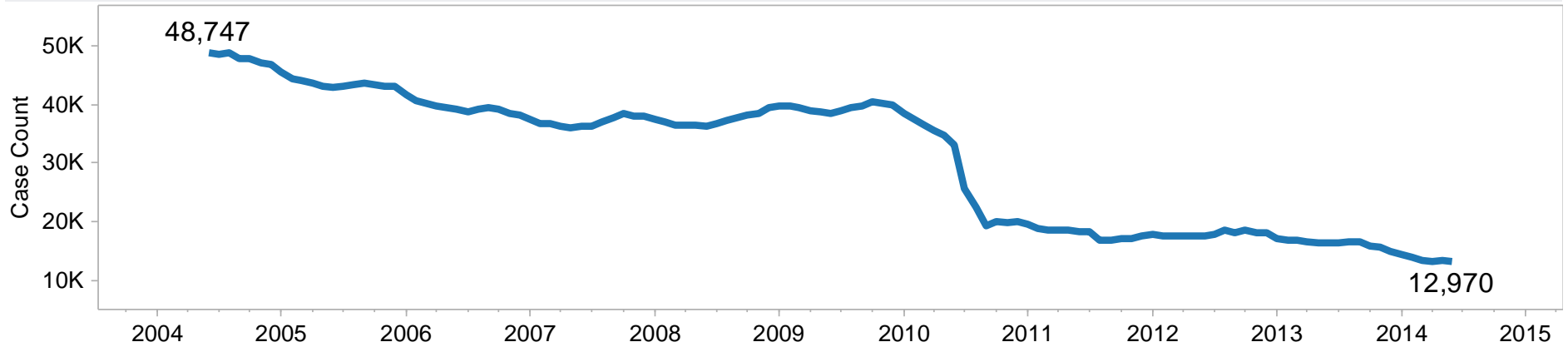
Tuberculosis Control

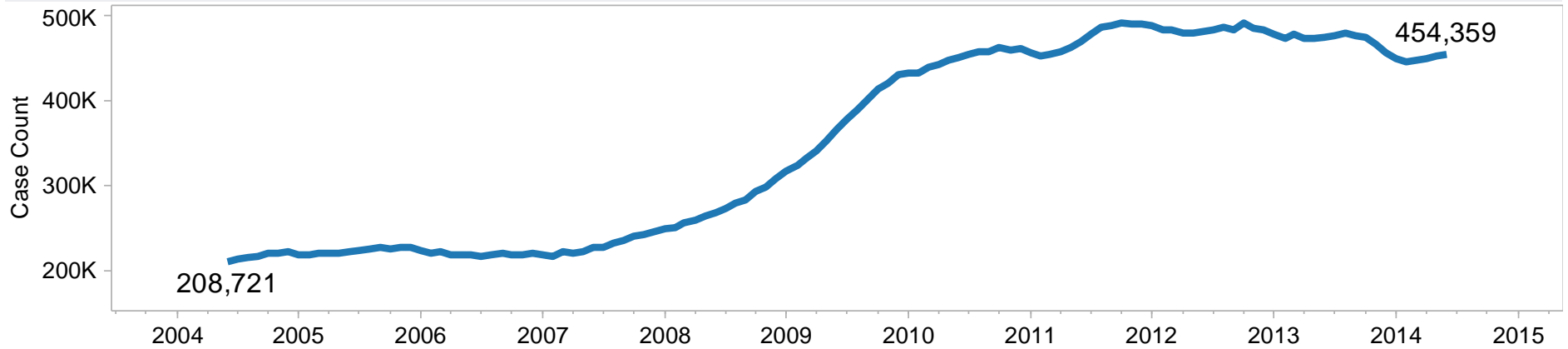

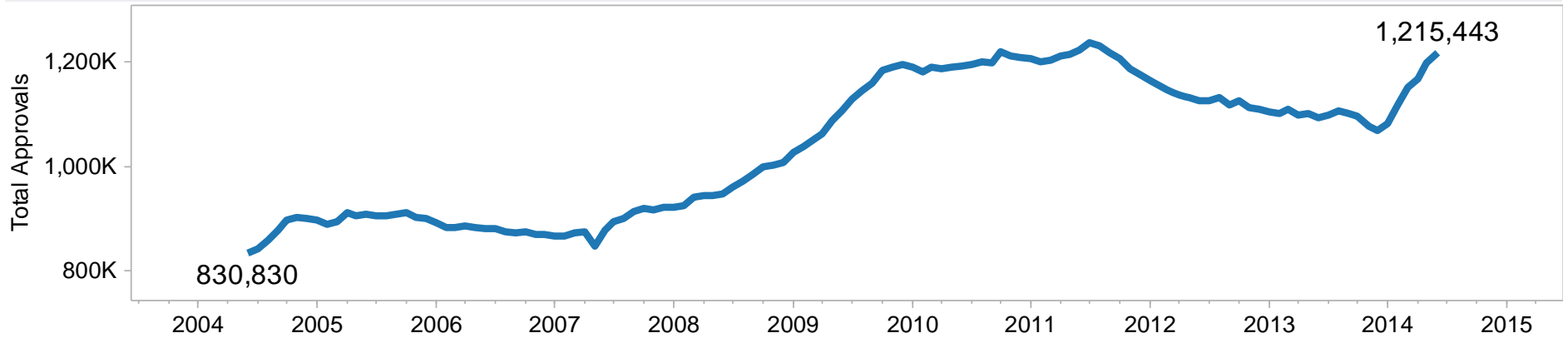
SNAP Cases
