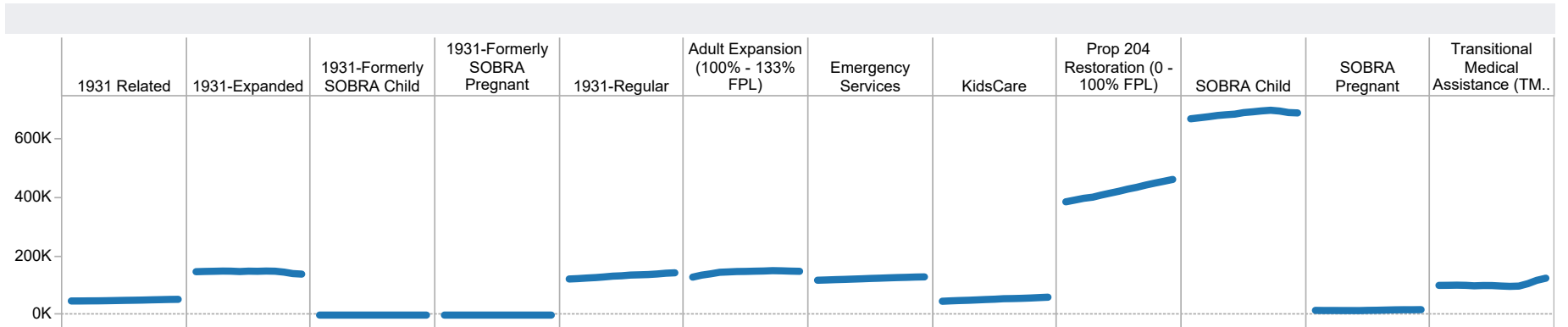
- Includes: Emergency Allotments to bring households up to the maximum benefit totaled \$64,977,137 issued, 333,310 families, and 692,775 persons. SNAP Households received a minimum EA benefit of \$95 beginning in April 2021. The increase in average issuance per case in May 2021 is due in part to EA benefits issued in May for the month of April.

- Excludes: P-EBT (Pandemic School Meals Replacement and Child Care Replacement) Program benefits are not SNAP benefits and are excluded. \$594,487 issued, 1,324 families, and 1,148 children. P-EBT families also receiving SNAP are included in families, persons, and children, but benefits issued are excluded.

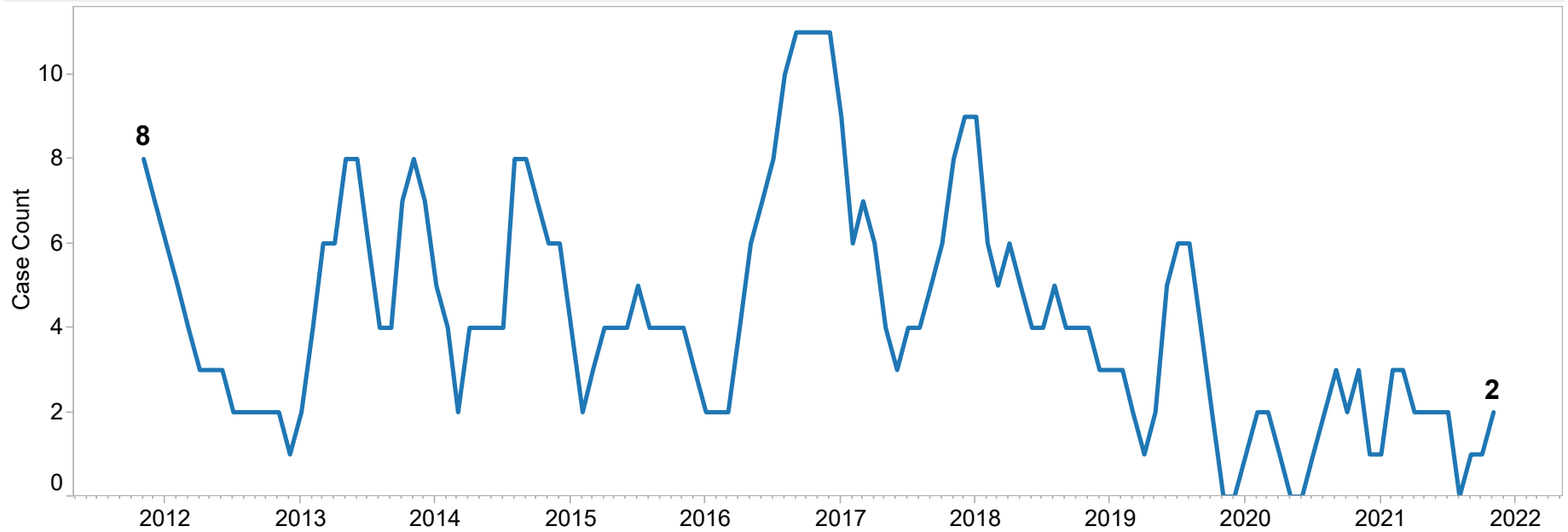

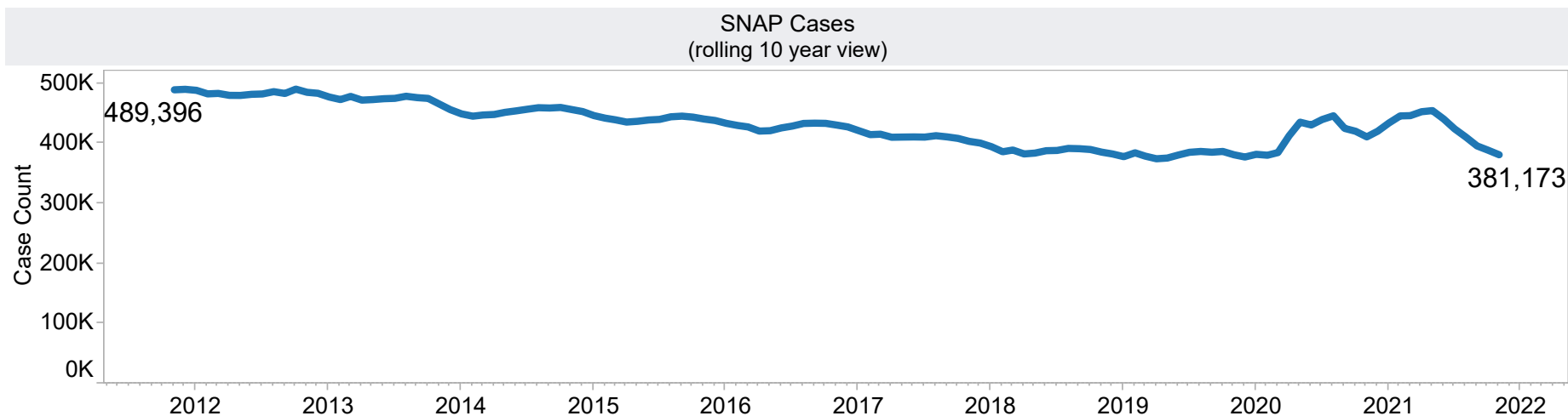


Tuberculosis Control

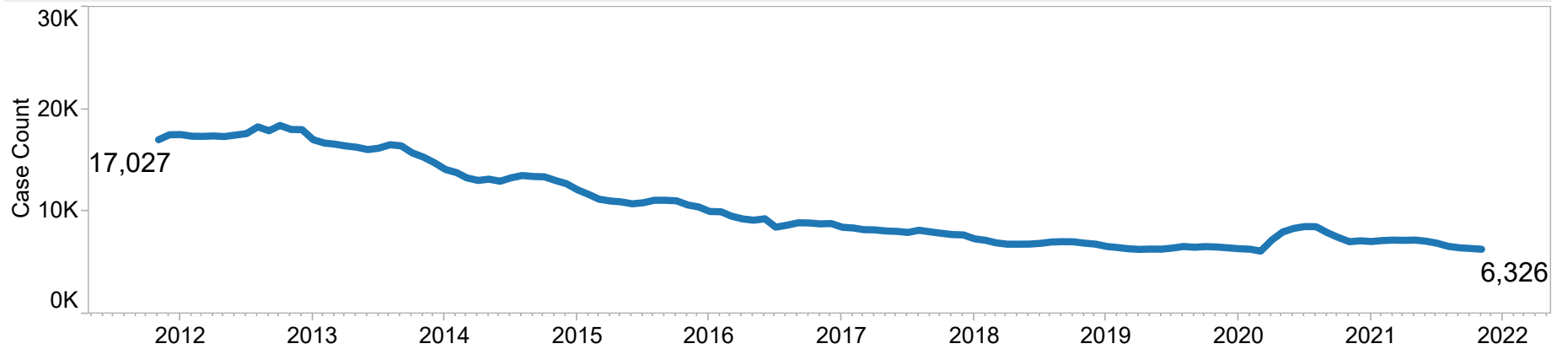
