



## CHILD CARE ASSISTANCE FOR FULL-TIME STUDENTS



### Did you know child care assistance is available for student parents in full-time education programs?

Parents currently receiving DES child care assistance who return to school full-time may request a work activity waiver to continue receiving child care assistance while completing education requirements.

#### Eligibility:

Students requesting this waiver must:

- Be receiving child care assistance through DES;
- Provide an attestation confirming the intent to participate in the program and to follow the rules and policies associated with the program; and
- Provide verification of enrollment in a full-time accredited educational institution, remedial education activity, or employment training program.
