

## **DIVISION OF DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES**

The Arizona Department of Health Services has adopted a COVID-19 vaccine distribution plan based on age. Now that more vaccine doses are available, they are increasing the number of people eligible. The State runs vaccination sites in Maricopa, Pima and Yuma counties. As of Wednesday, March 24, 2021, any Arizonan that is age 16 or older can register to receive the vaccine at one of these locations. These locations are:

- State Farm Stadium in Glendale
- Phoenix Municipal Stadium in Phoenix
- · Chandler/Gilbert Community College in Chandler
- The University of Arizona in Tucson
- The Yuma Convention Center in Yuma.

You can make an appointment online at <u>podvaccine.azdhs.gov</u> or by calling 1-844-542-8201. Eligible Medicaid members can get non-emergency medical transportation (NEMT) to their vaccine appointment even if it is at a drive through site. Contact your health insurance provider for more details.

<u>Coconino County:</u> DD members can register for vaccination appointments at Flagstaff Medical Center (FMC) or Coconino County Health & Human Services Ft. <u>Gila County:</u> All Gila County residents who are age 18 and older can register online to be vaccinated at <u>www.gilahealth.com/covid-19/covid-19-vaccine</u>. Individuals without Internet access can get help by calling:

**Graham County:** Any Graham County resident who is age 18 years and older and would like a COVID-19 vaccination may contact their primary care physician or schedule an appointment at <a href="https://www.graham.az.gov">www.graham.az.gov</a>.

<u>Greenlee County:</u> All Greenlee County residents who are age 18 and older can register online to be vaccinated at <a href="https://www.gilahealth.com/covid-19/covid-19-vaccine">https://www.gilahealth.com/covid-19/covid-19-vaccine</a>.

<u>Maricopa County:</u> All Maricopa County residents aged 18 and older for those receiving the Moderna and Janssen vaccine and 16 and older for those receiving the Pfizer vaccine are eligible to receive the vaccine. <u>Pima County:</u> Registration is open to "Adults 18 years and over, living with disabilities (physical, intellectual/developmental, mental health and /or sensory) and/or high risk medical conditions who are receiving long term care service at home." Vaccinations are available at Tucson Medical Center, Banner Kino or at Tucson Convention Center. Members can register at one of these sites online:

<u>Pinal County:</u> All individuals who are 18 and older (with no contraindications to the vaccinations) are eligible for COVID vaccines at Pinal County locations - if they live or work in Pinal County.
