Be Sun Wise

Whether you enjoy the snow in the high country or the picture perfect weather in the deserts, Winter is a great time to be outdoors in Arizona. The sun's rays are just as dangerous in the Winter as they are in the Summer. You can spend all day outside in the cool weather and still get a sunburn. Carbon Monoxide Safety



Carbon monoxide deaths in Arizona spike during colder months. Many homes use gas furnaces or other sources of heating including fireplaces and generators. Carbon monoxide detectors can save your life. Ensure adequate ventilation for fireplaces. Never use a generator indoors or near an open window. Install carbon monoxide detectors in central locations in your home. Move to an area with fresh air if the carbon monoxide alarm goes off and call 911.

Affordable Housing

DDD now has affordable housing options available in both Maricopa and Pima counties. Availability is limited and a waitlist exists for all properties. Applicants need to:

- Be eligible for DDD and Arizona Long Term Care Services (ALTCS)
- Be between the ages of 18-61
- Have a current Individual Support Plan (ISP)
- Meet financial eligibility and Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requirements
