Restitution:

- A. Means the act of paying or compensating for property loss or damage;
- B. Does not include voluntary compensation by a parent or guardian; and
- C. May not infringe on an individual's rights protected by A.R.S. § 36-551.

Providers are required to have insurance to cover property loss or damage. If a member damages the property of another, the injured party may have a legal remedy in the small claims division of the Justice Courts.

The Division and its contracted providers cannot make restitution a condition for provision of services or supports. A Member's Behaviors cannot prevent that member from receiving services through the Division. Behaviors that result in property damage or loss should be addressed by the Planning Team.
