SUBJECT: Instruction Memo No. B-059 Educational Institutions - Separations

- A. For uniformity in adjudicating the separation of a school employee from an educational institution, the following guidelines shall be used.
 - 1. The separation is considered a discharge when:
 - a. Employment of a school employee is terminated or he is replaced during the school term;
 - b. The school district does not offer a contractual employee continuing employment in same or similar capacity for the next school term for reasons other than declining enrollment or lack of funding;
 - c. The school district informs an employee prior to the beginning of the next school term there is no assurance of continuing employment for reasons other than declining enrollment or lack of funding.
 - 2. The separation is considered a voluntary leaving when:
 - a. The school employee chooses not to sign a contract or intentionally avoids an offer of a renewed contract for the next school term prior to the end of the current school term;
 - b. The school employee signs a contract during the school term for the next school term and subsequently decides to resign. The separation date is the date the resignation is submitted.
 - c. The school employee has not been offered a contract for the next school term but has a reasonable assurance of rehire. During the period between school terms, the individual notifies the school district he/she will not return or refuses a contract when offered.
 - 3. A refusal of work determination will be made when:
 - a. A school employee filing for benefits during the period between terms does not have a contract for or a reasonable

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assurance of continuing employment for the next school term, but during the period between terms is offered continuing employment which is not accepted.

- b. A school employee is offered a contract for the next school term in a different capacity and refuses the contract. (New Work).
- 4. When a school employee's separation is other than a lack of work, the use of the wages from an educational institution is not a separate issue since there is not a contract or reasonable assurance of continued employment.
