
# AzEIP Approved Screening and Evaluation Instruments

All screening and evaluation instruments must be the latest edition or the most up-to-date version. Personnel who administer test instruments must be appropriately trained and have the appropriate credentials that meet the requirements specified within each of the instruments. Screening and evaluation instruments not identified on the approved instrument list must be sent to AzEIP for approval before use.

Screening instruments are used to provide a look at a child's development, including vision and hearing, to determine if there are potential developmental concerns that should be explored through evaluation.

Evaluation instruments are used in conjunction with a review of records, interview/parent report, observation, interaction and play-based measures to determine a child's initial or ongoing eligibility for AzEIP.

When a child is under the age of 12 months, the multidisciplinary evaluation team must review available documentation and choose age-appropriate instruments for the evaluation of very young infants.

#### Approved discipline-specific instruments

Discipline-specific instruments may be used in addition to an evaluation instrument listed above but may not be used in lieu of those instruments. A discipline-specific instrument may be used to obtain a standard score in the associated area of development and may be used in place of the same developmental area of an approved evaluation instrument, ensuring one standard score for all areas of development is obtained.
