The Independent Living Older Blind Program helps individuals who are 55 and older with significant visual impairments live independently in the home and community. Participants are empowered and provided with opportunities to learn skills to help them optimize their abilities and experience fewer disruptions to daily activities.

Services offered through the ILOB program are designed to help older individuals adjust to living with blindness.

You may be eligible for ILOB services if you meet all of the following requirements:
