## Benefit Amount and Benefit Term

How much am I eligible for?	\$187 - \$240/wk	\$117 - \$240/wk	\$187 - \$240/wk	Additional \$600/wk
How long am I eligible for Benefits?	Up to 26 Weeks	Up to 39 Weeks (Available for weeks of unemployment from 2/2/20 to 12/26/20)	Up to 13 additional Weeks of UI Benefits (Available for weeks of unemployment from 3/29/20 to 12/26/20)	For weeks receiving UI, PUA or PEUC benefits between 3/29/20 and 7/25/20

## Scenarios (Note: Eligibility for each program is determined on a case-by-case basis)
