

What is Disability Benefits 101?

Arizona Disability Benefits 101 (AZ DB101) provides tools and information on health coverage, benefits, and employment - allowing people with disabilities to plan ahead and learn how work and benefits go together.

AZ DB101 gives providers the ability to accurately, confidently, and effortlessly deliver information about basic benefit planning, employment services, and additional support resources.

Content

Each section of Arizona DB101 has a wealth of information for providers to share with people with disabilities to encourage and support employment goals.

- **Supplemental Security Income (SSI)** section explains the complex rules related to receiving SSI including eligibility. Find explanations and resources to figure out benefits, countable income, and how to maximize earnings while working.
- **Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI)** section explains the rules for the SSDI program, including determining eligibility and navigating employment while receiving SSDI.
- **Finding the Right Health Coverage For You** is an interactive tool to explore health coverage options.
- **AHCCCS and AHCCCS for People with Disabilities** introduces healthcare coverage for people with and without disabilities who have low income.
- **Medicare** explains public health coverage for people with disabilities and seniors.
- **Building Your Assets and Wealth** highlights programs that can help build savings without risking the loss of disability benefits.
- **Benefits for Young People** sections explain benefit programs that help young people go to school, work, and save.
- **Programs that Support Work** explains programs that can help people with disabilities to prepare for and find work.
