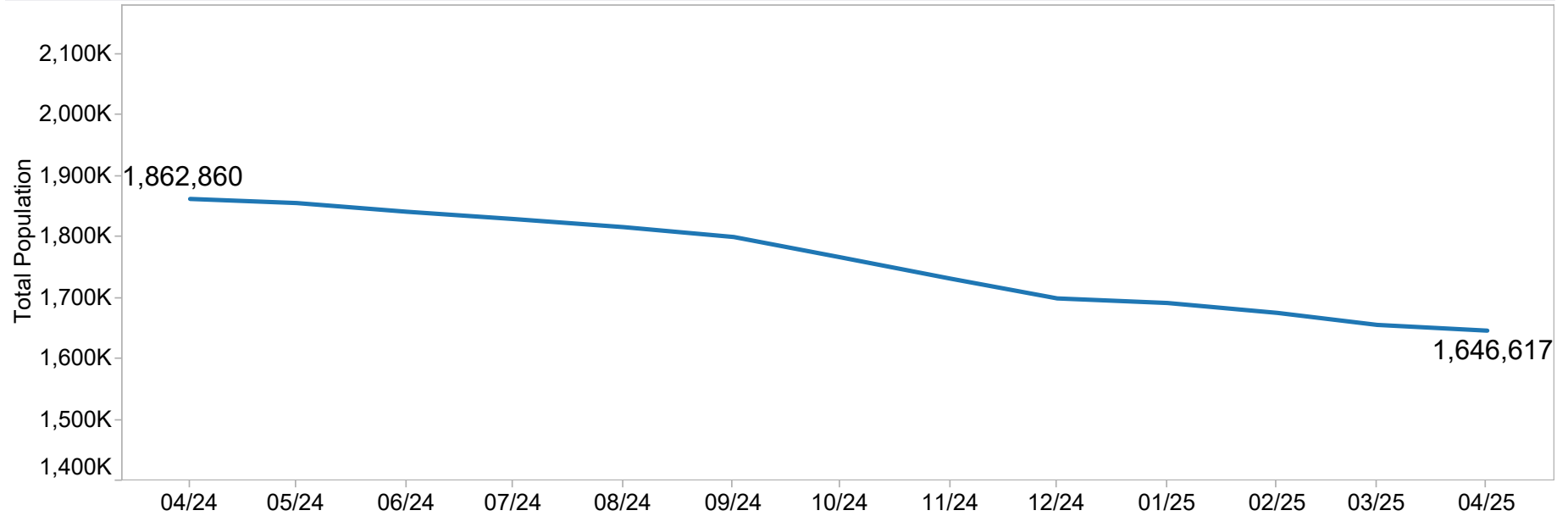

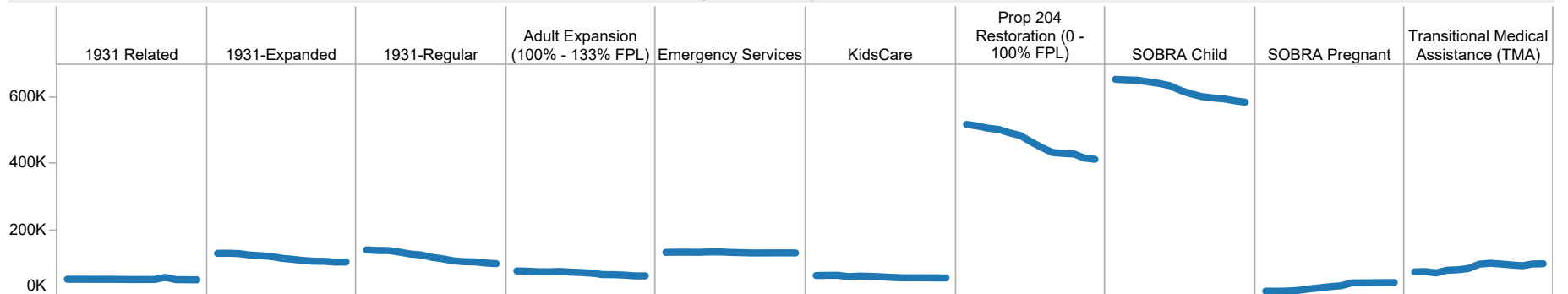

1 Year Sparkline Population Trend

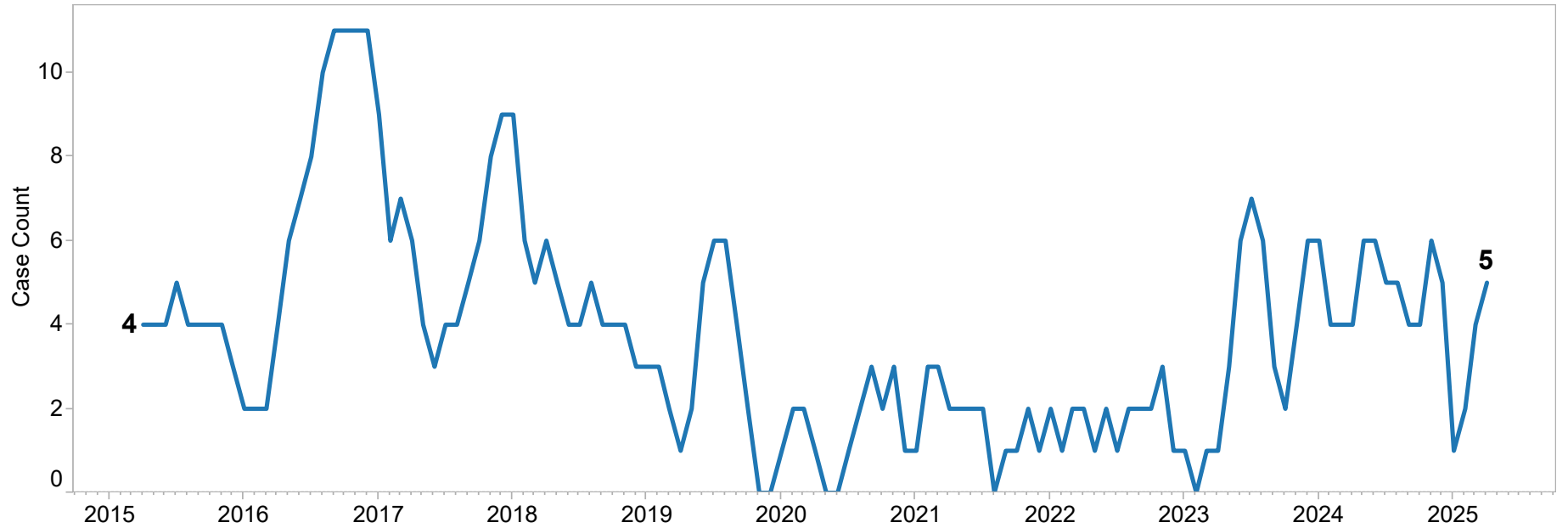

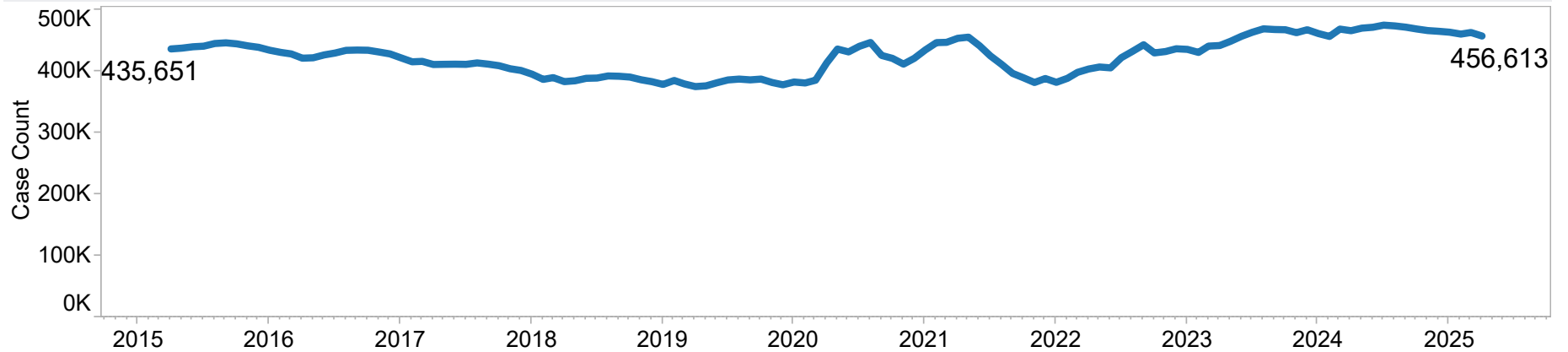

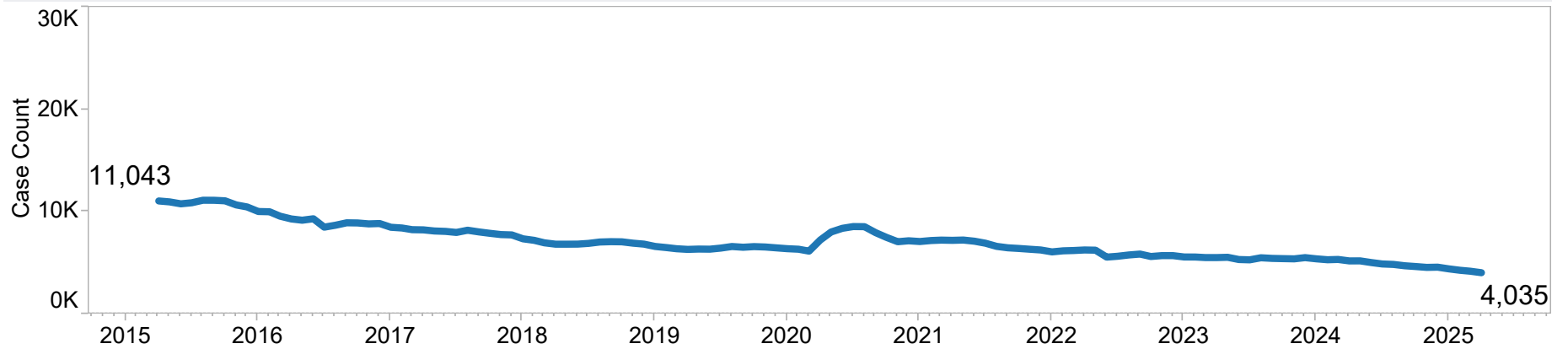
