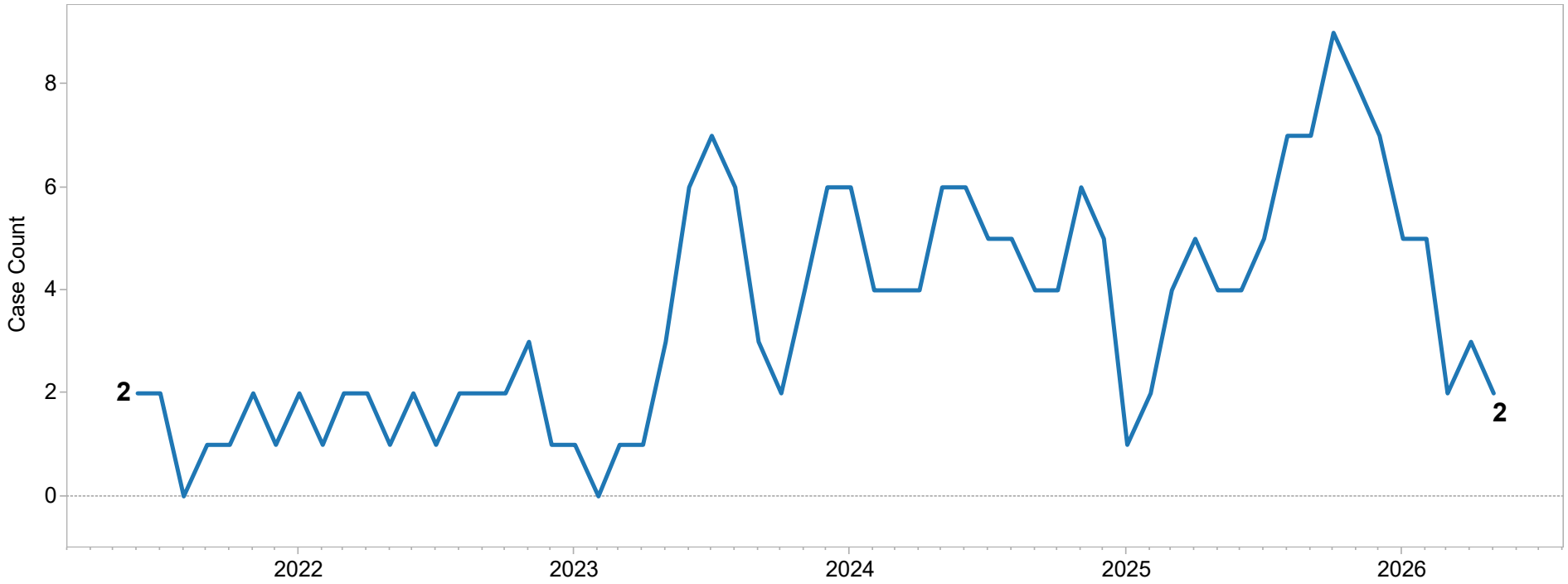

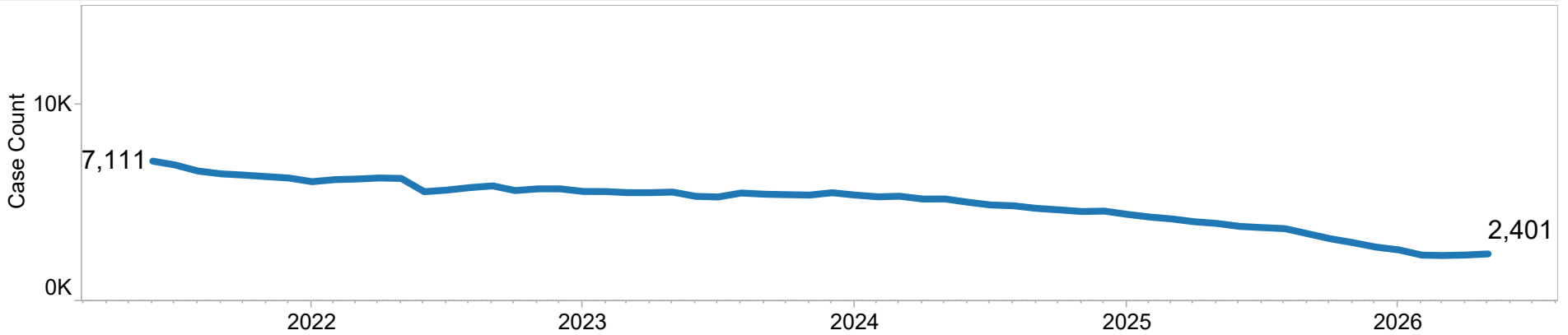
**Tuberculosis Control
