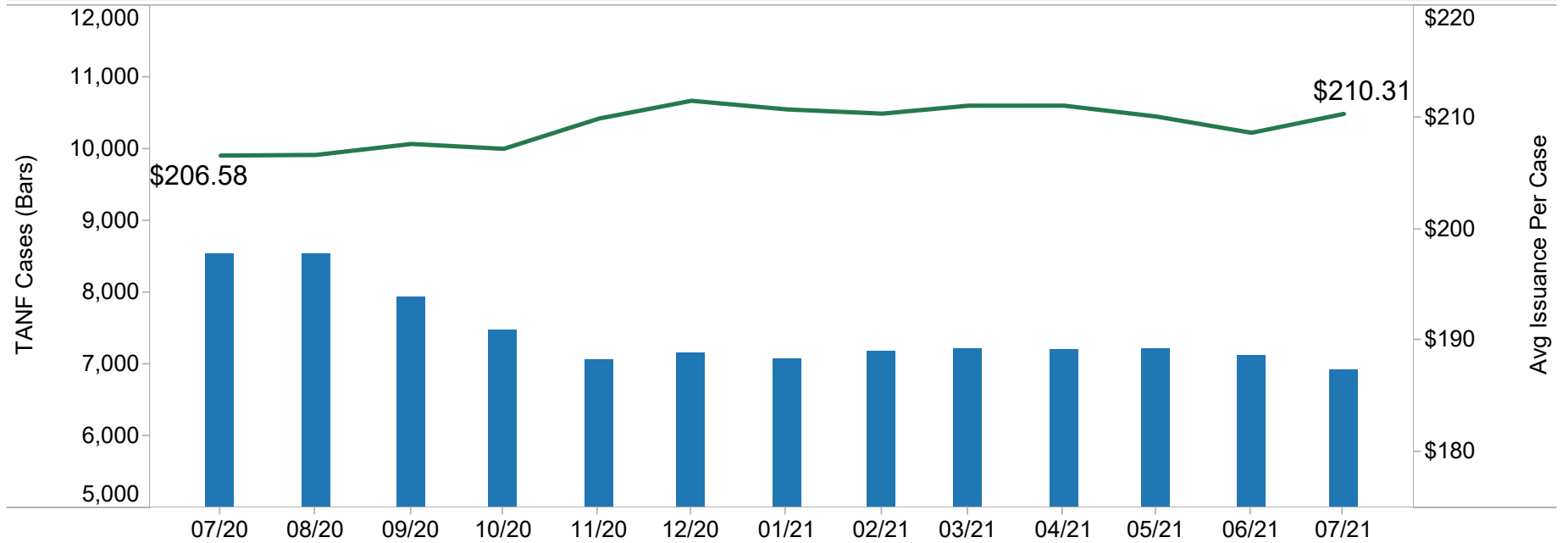

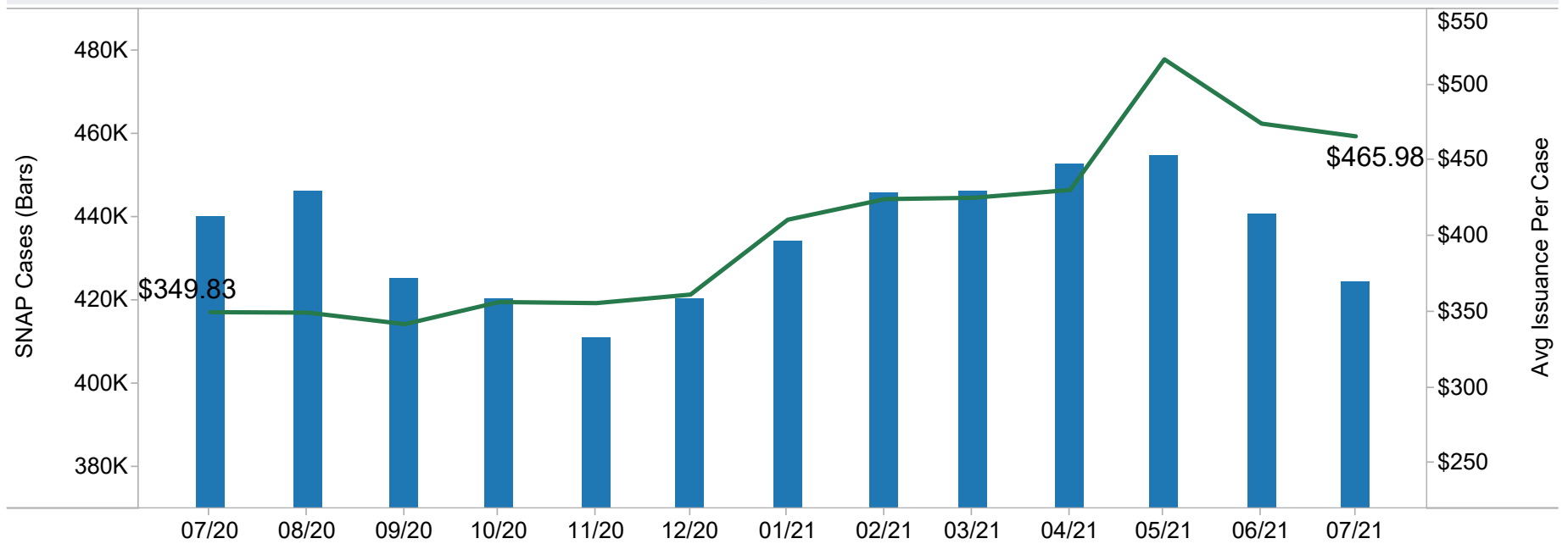

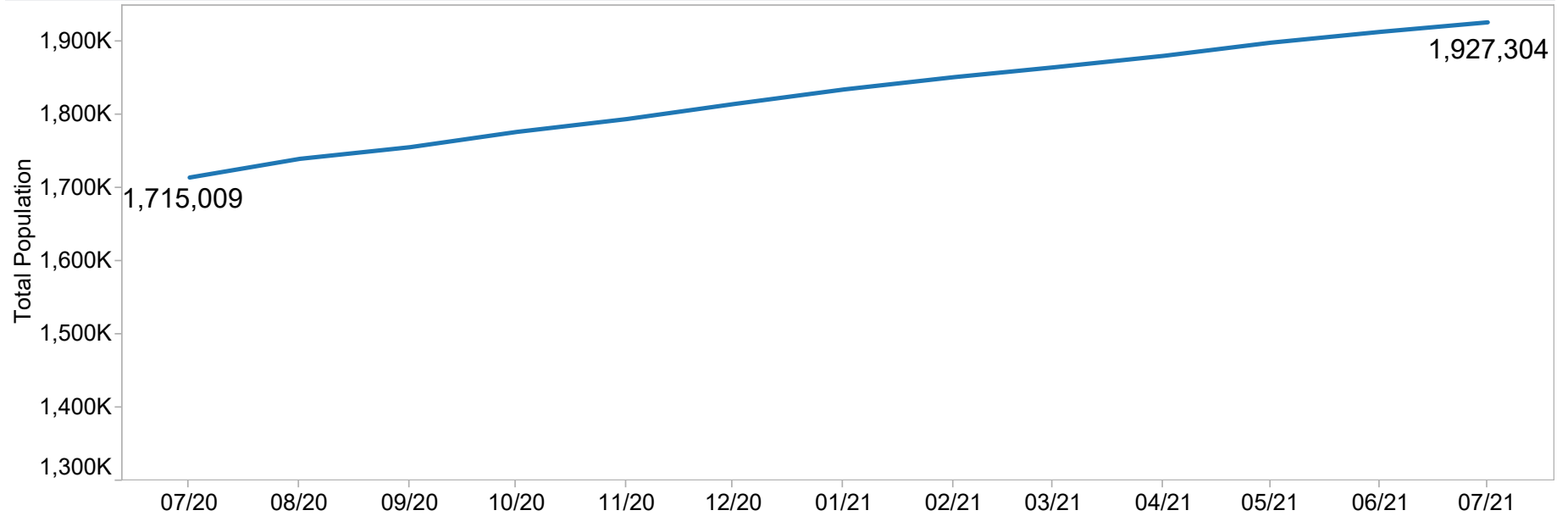

FF Coronavirus Response Act - H.R. 6201 adjustments:

- Includes: Emergency Allotments to bring households up to the maximum benefit totaled \$70,811,811 issued, 395,661 families, and 828,139 persons. SNAP Households received a minimum EA benefit of \$95 beginning in April 2021. The increase in average issuance per case in May 2021 is due in part to EA benefits issued in May for the month of April.

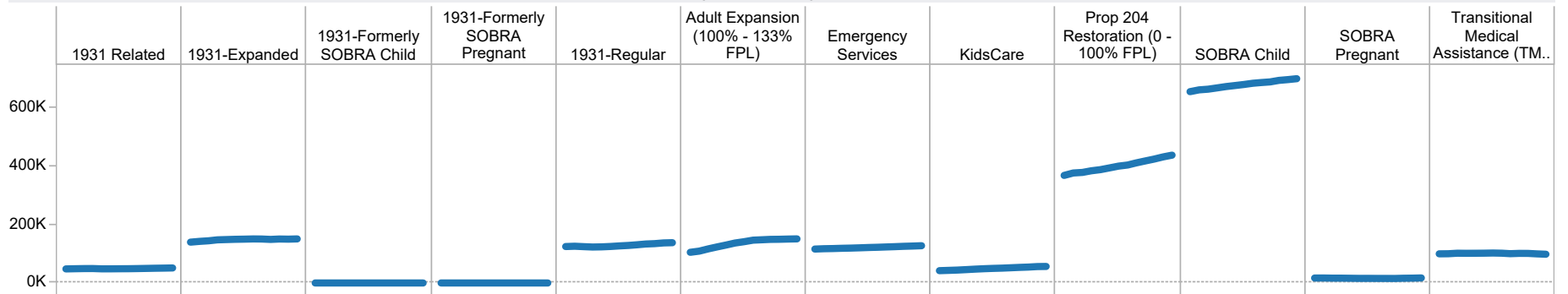

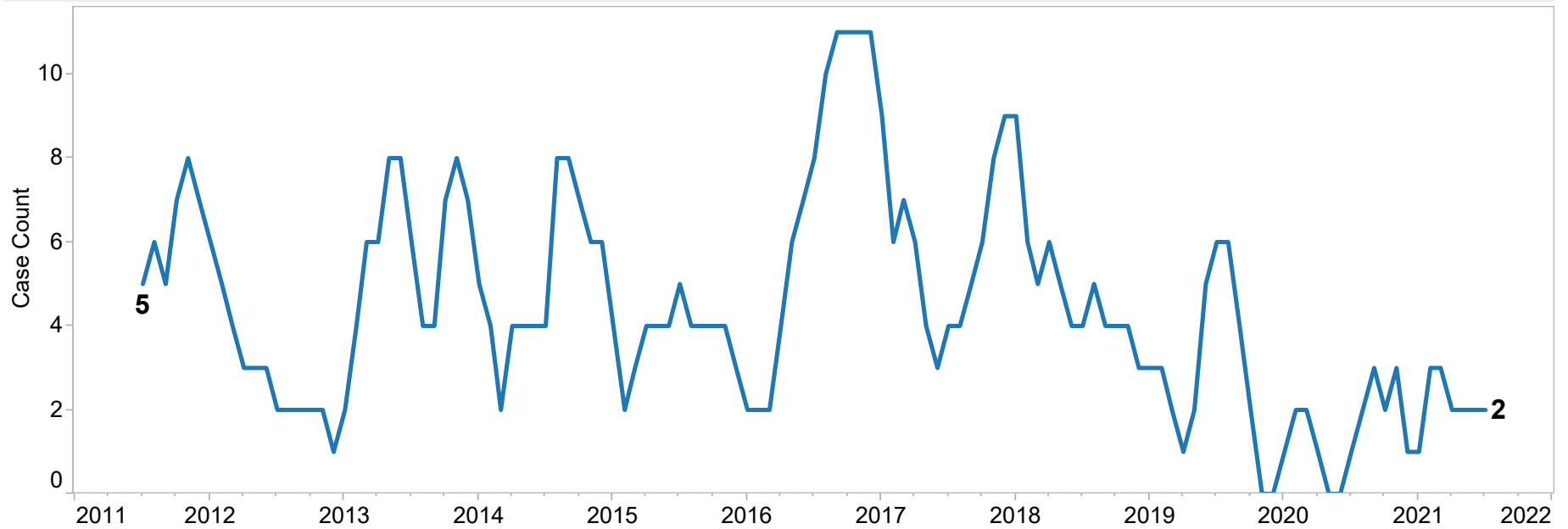

### 1 Year Sparkline Population Trend

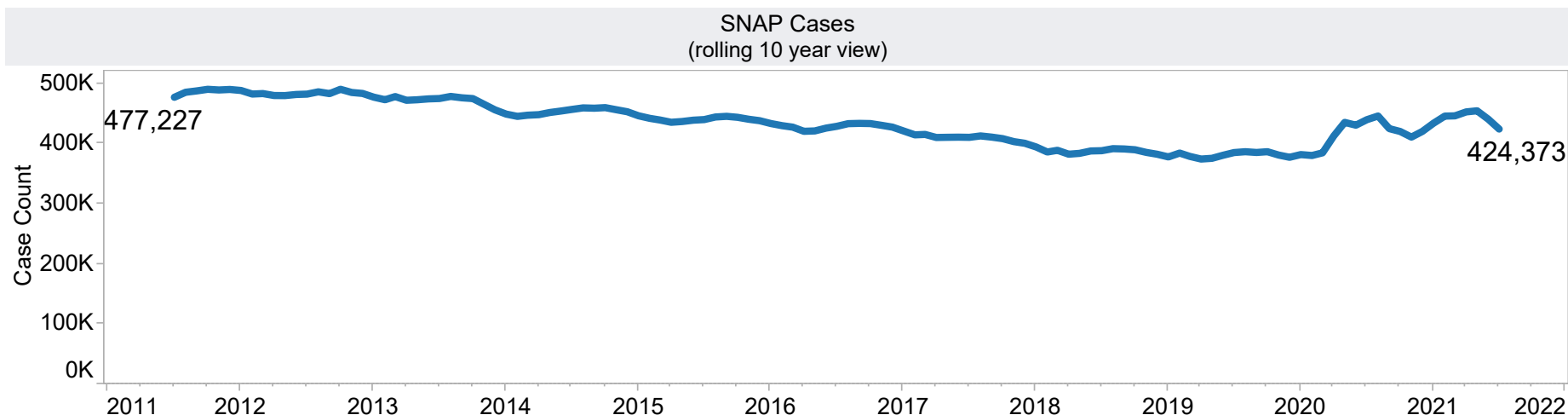


Tuberculosis Control

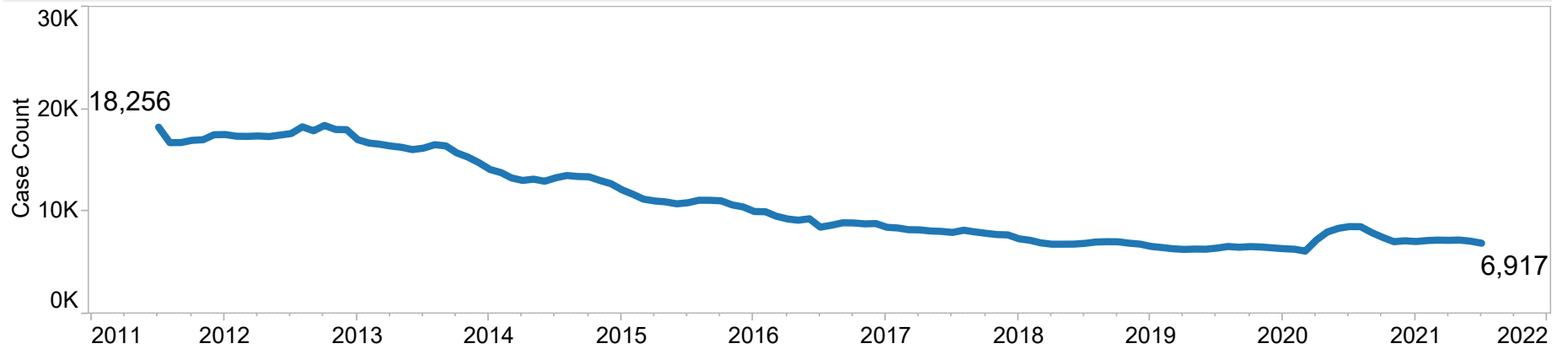
