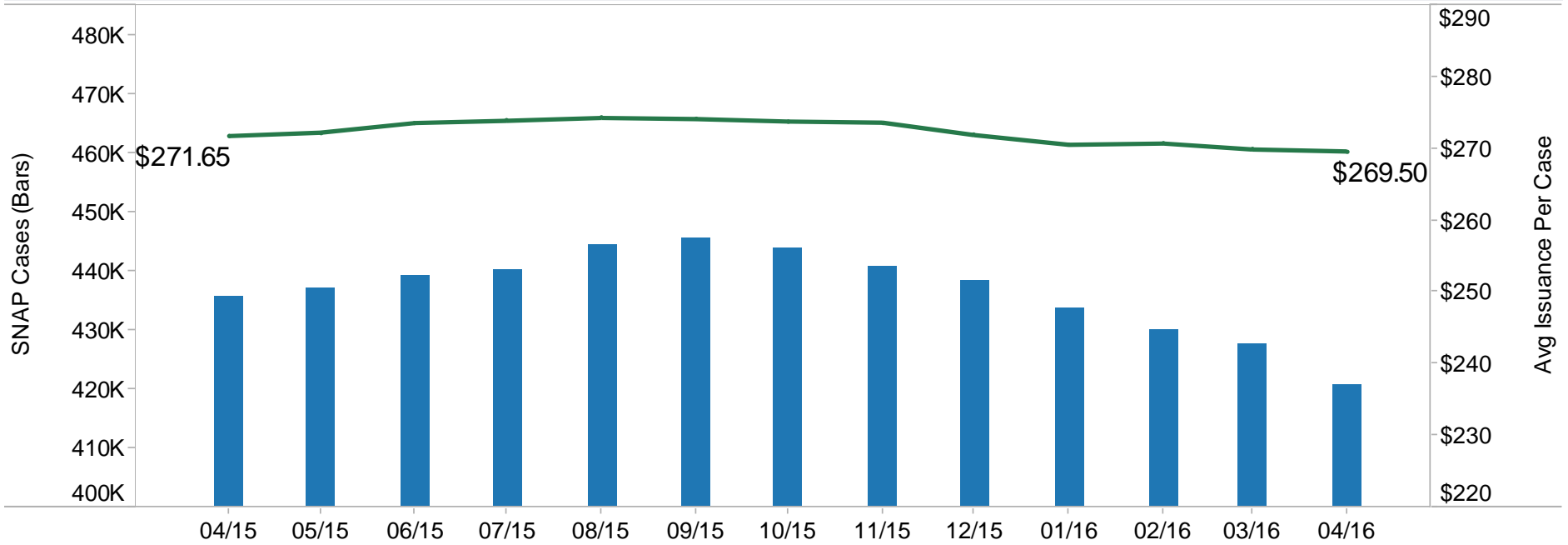

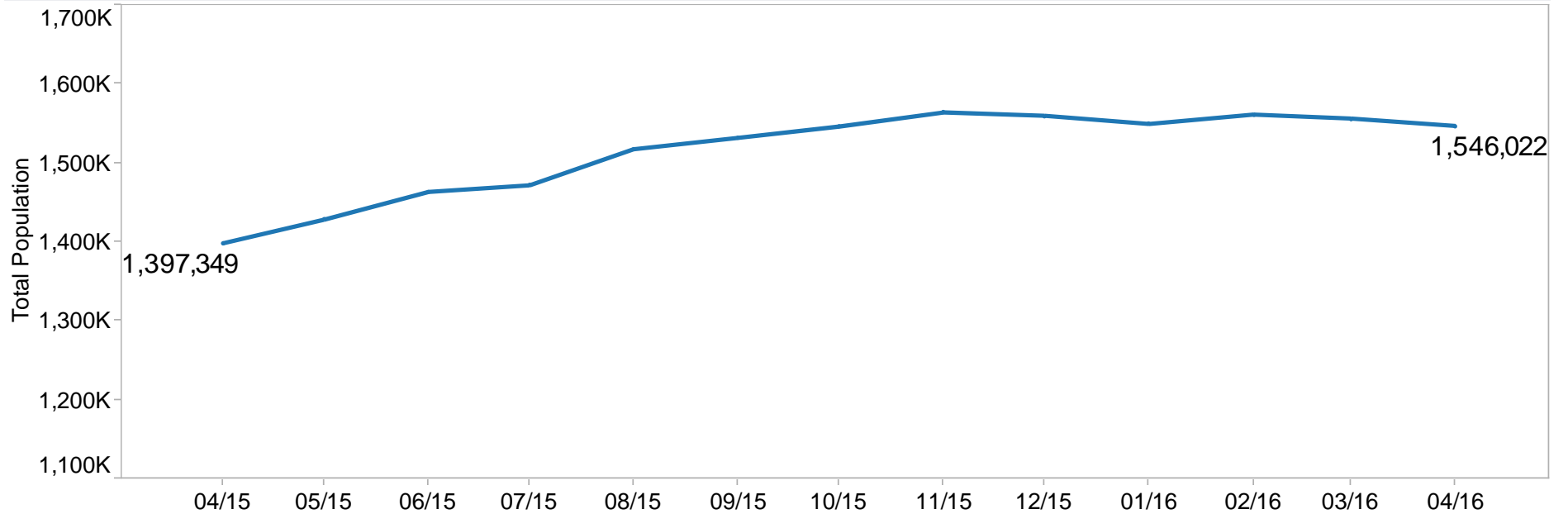

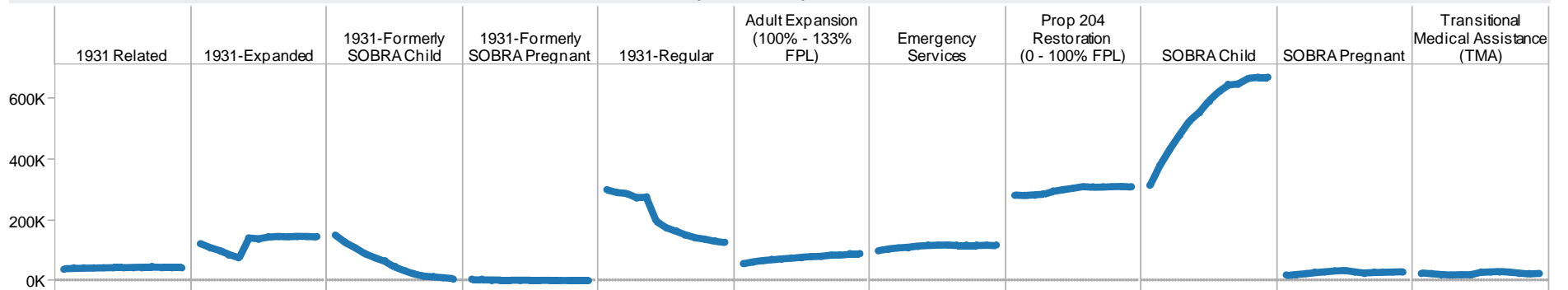

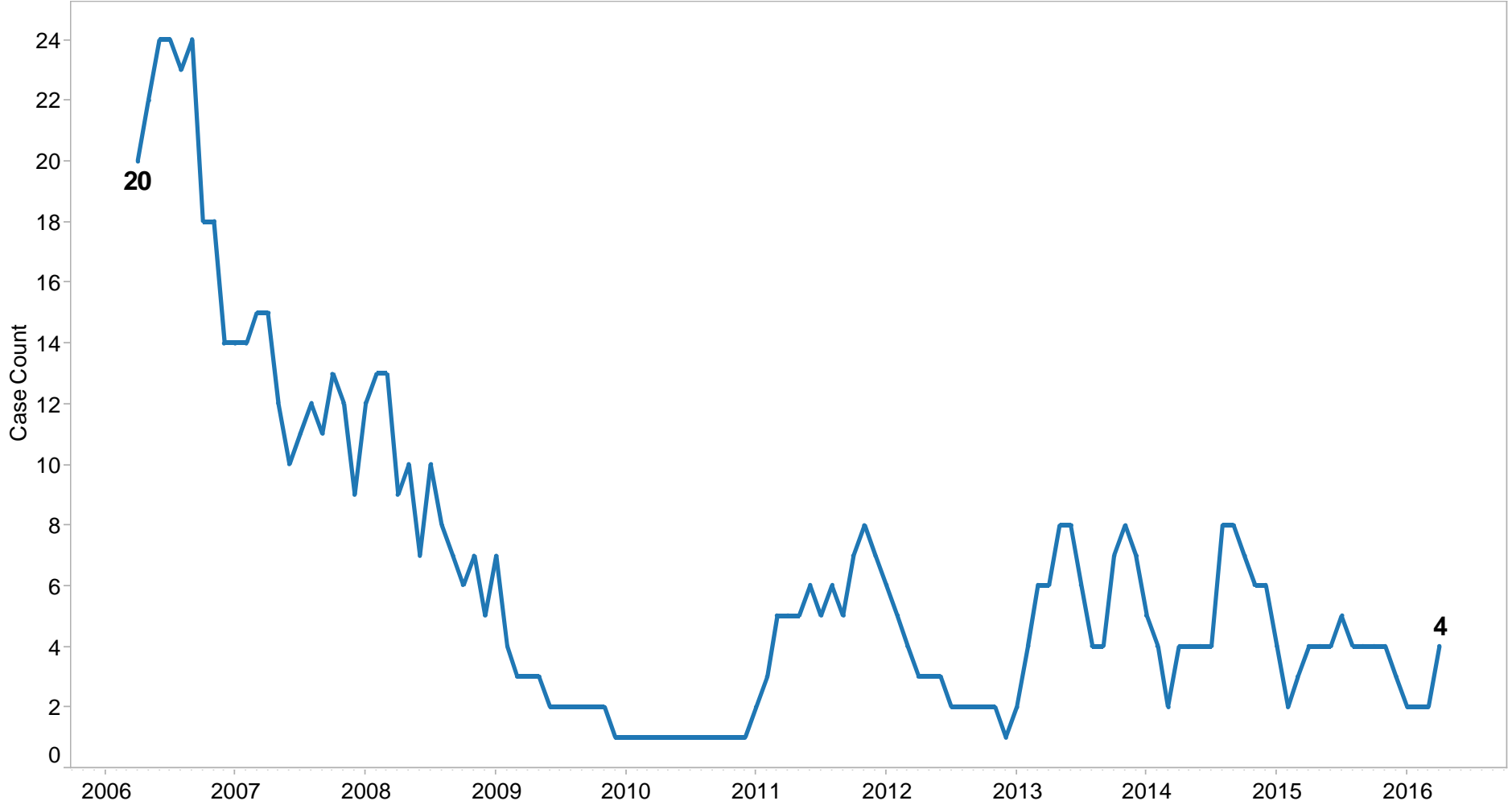

1 Year Sparkline Population Trend



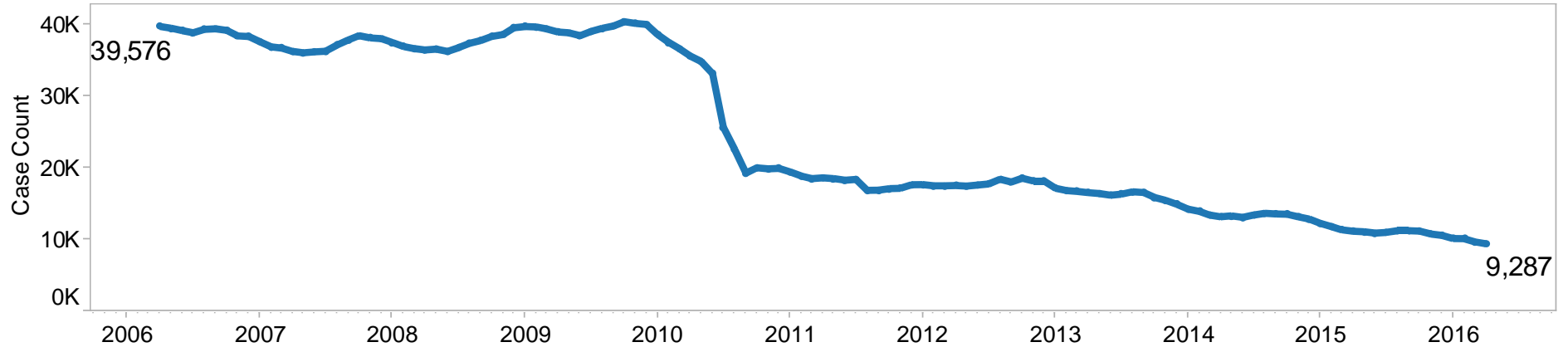
Tuberculosis Control

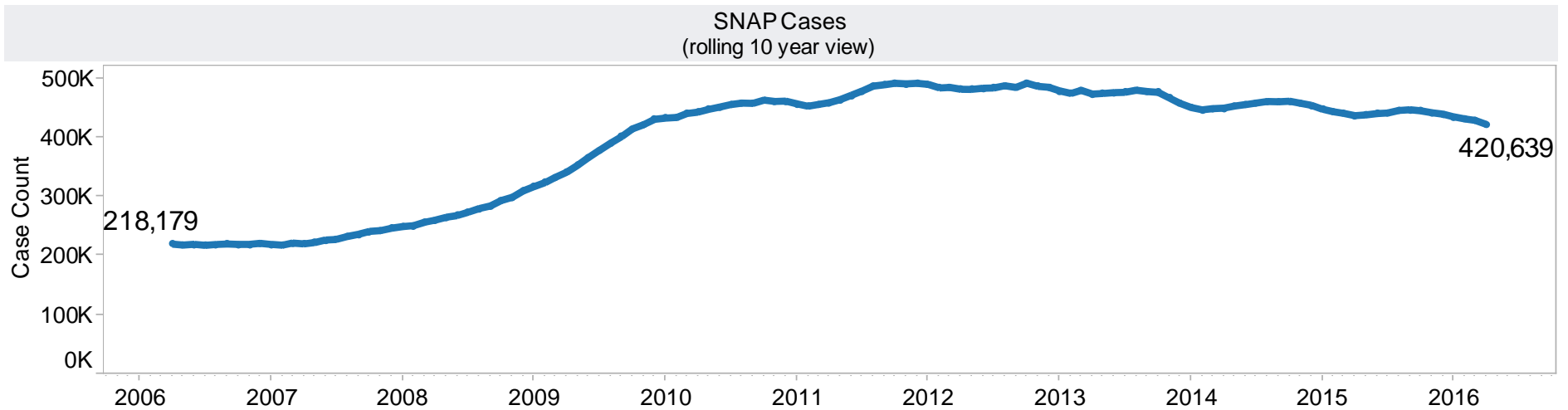
