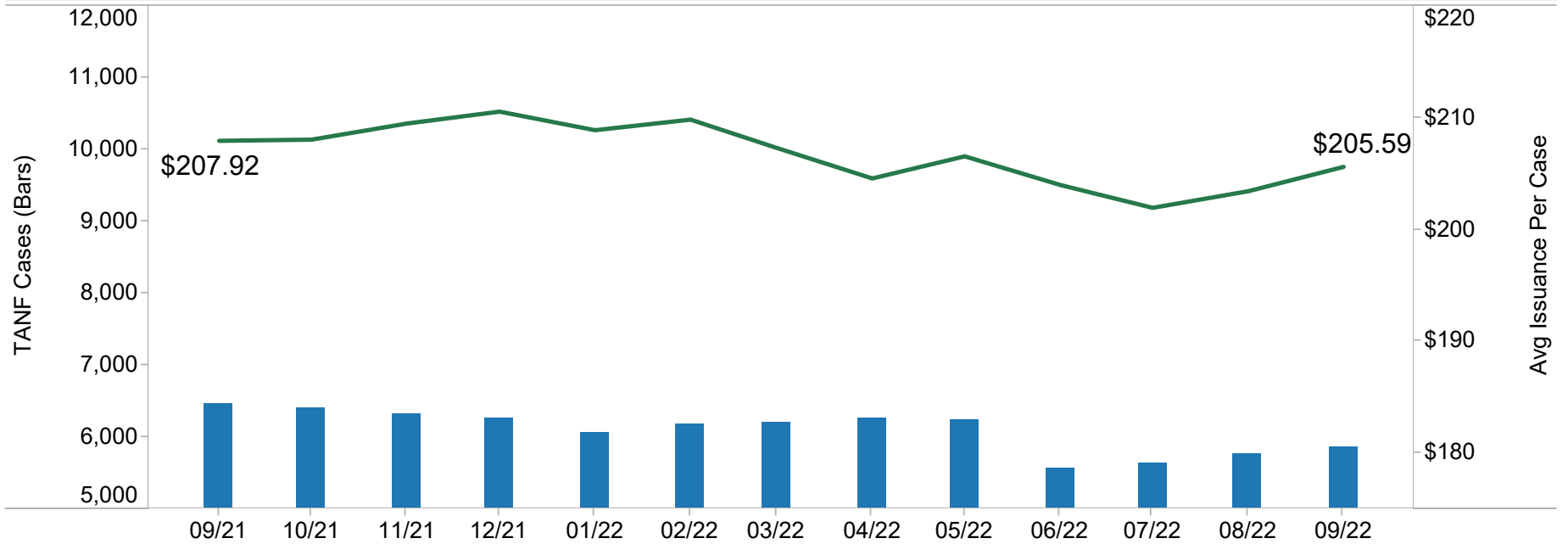

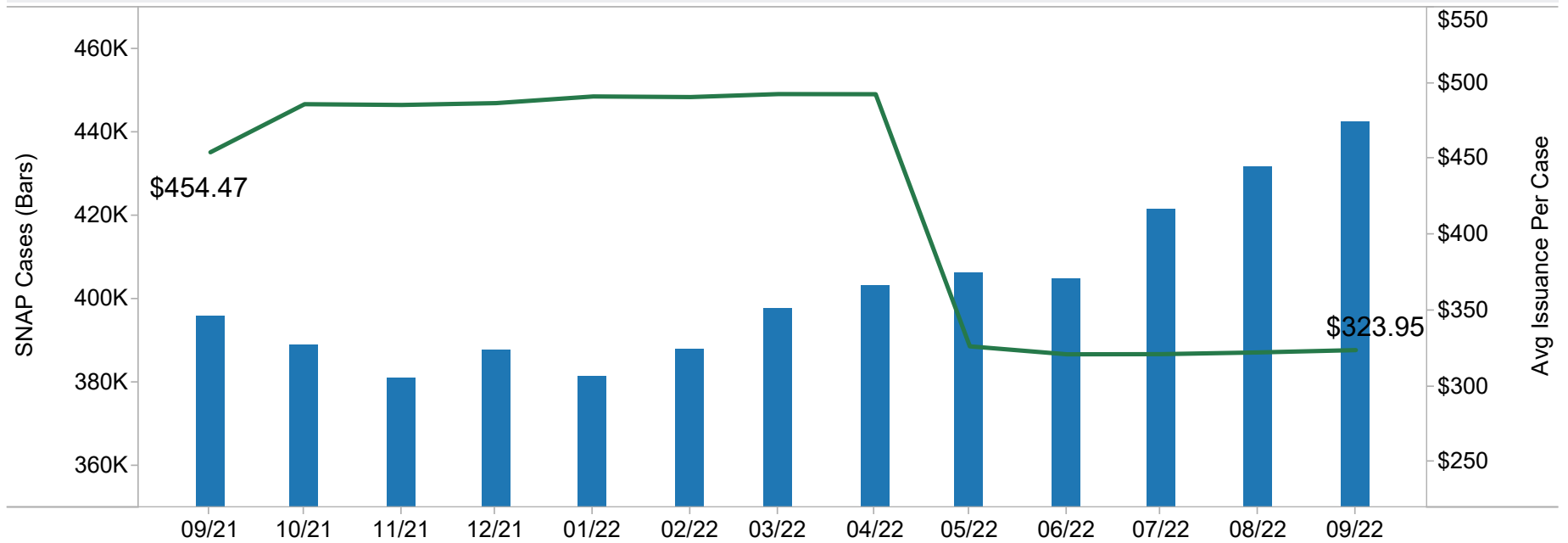

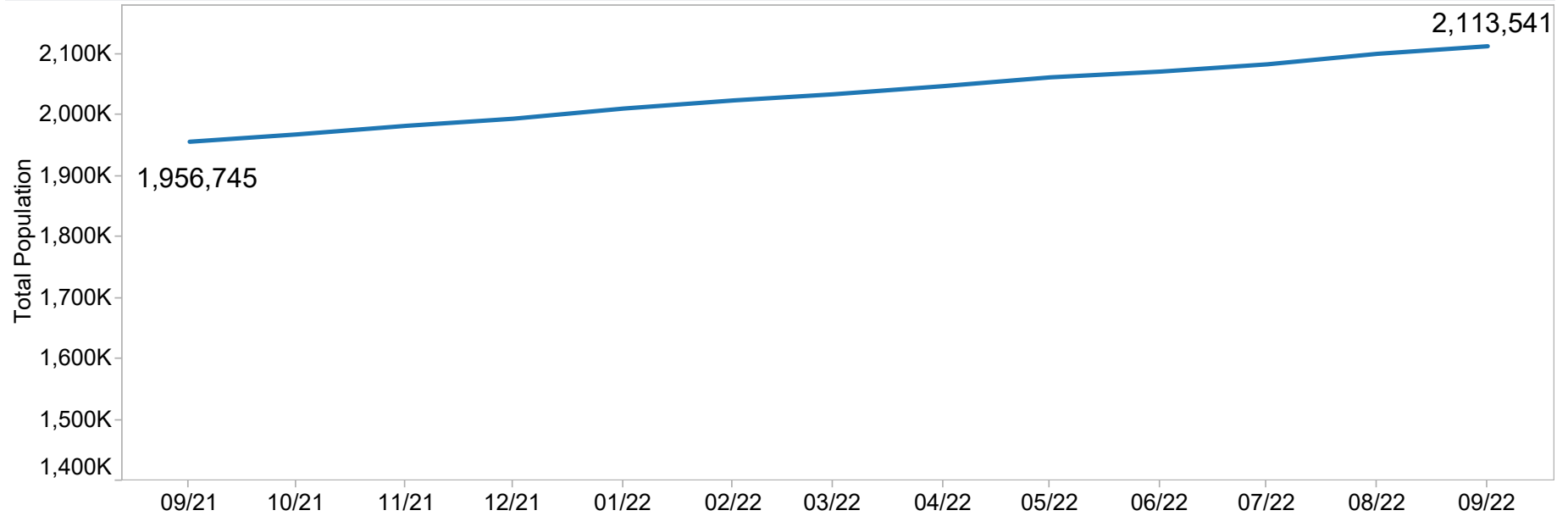

FF Coronavirus Response Act - H.R. 6201 adjustments:

- Includes: Catch-up Emergency Allotments to bring households up to the maximum benefits totaled \$800 issued, 2 families, and 2 persons. SNAP Households received a minimum EA benefit of \$95 beginning in April 2021 and ending April 2022. The increase in average issuance per case in May 2021 is due in part to EA benefits issued in May for the month of April. The decrease in Total Issuance and Average Issuance per Case in May 2022 is due to emergency allotment benefits ending in April 2022.

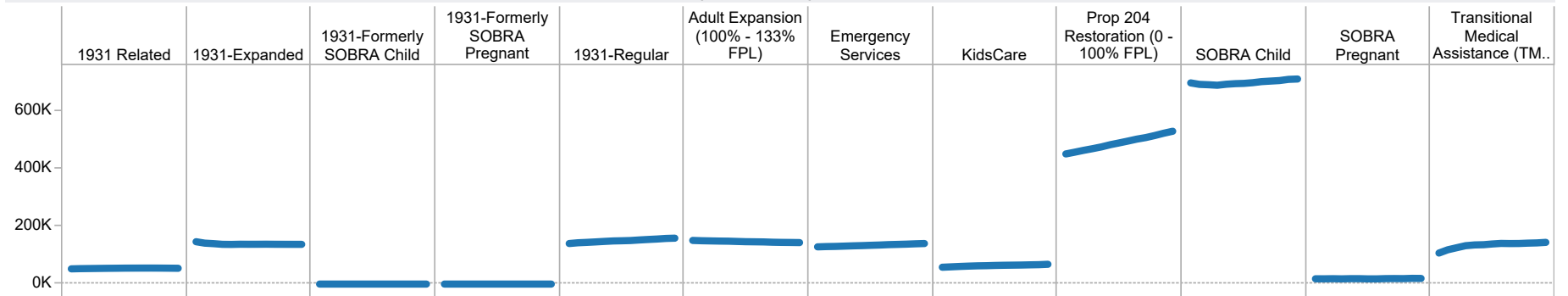

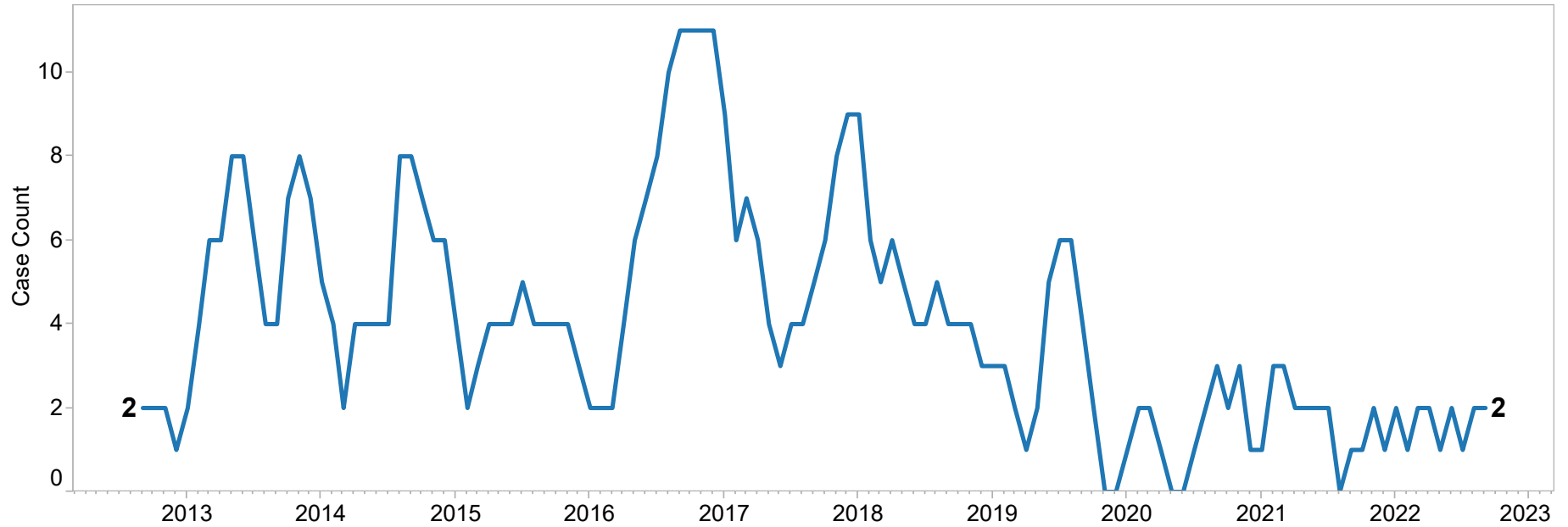

1 Year Sparkline Population Trend



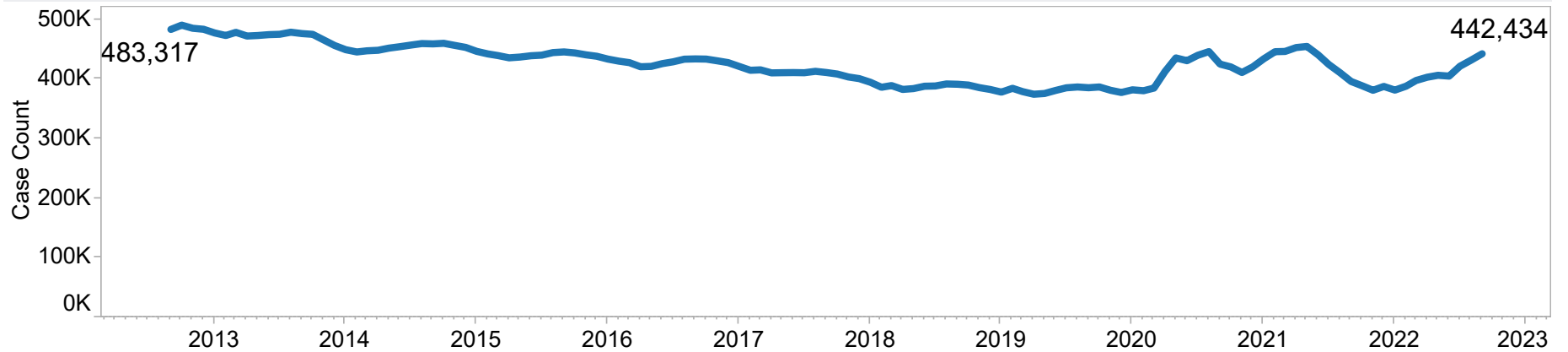
**Tuberculosis Control

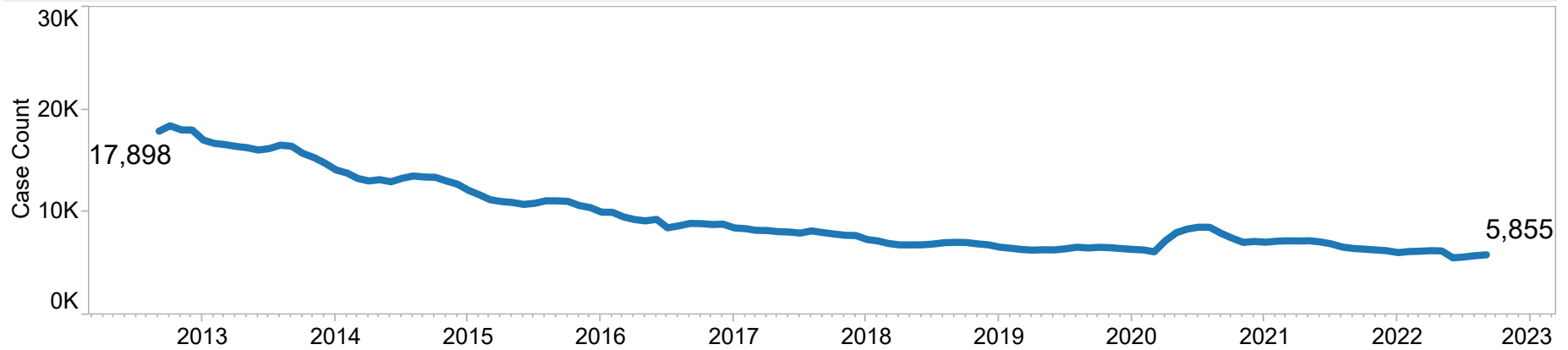
