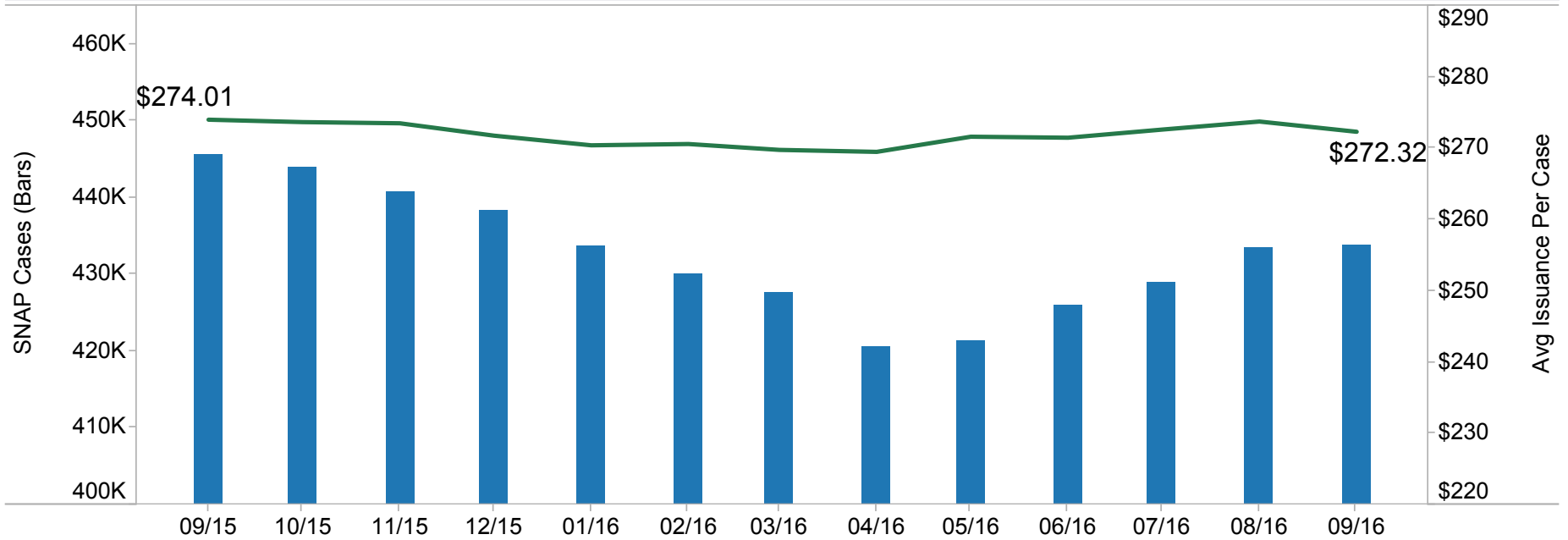

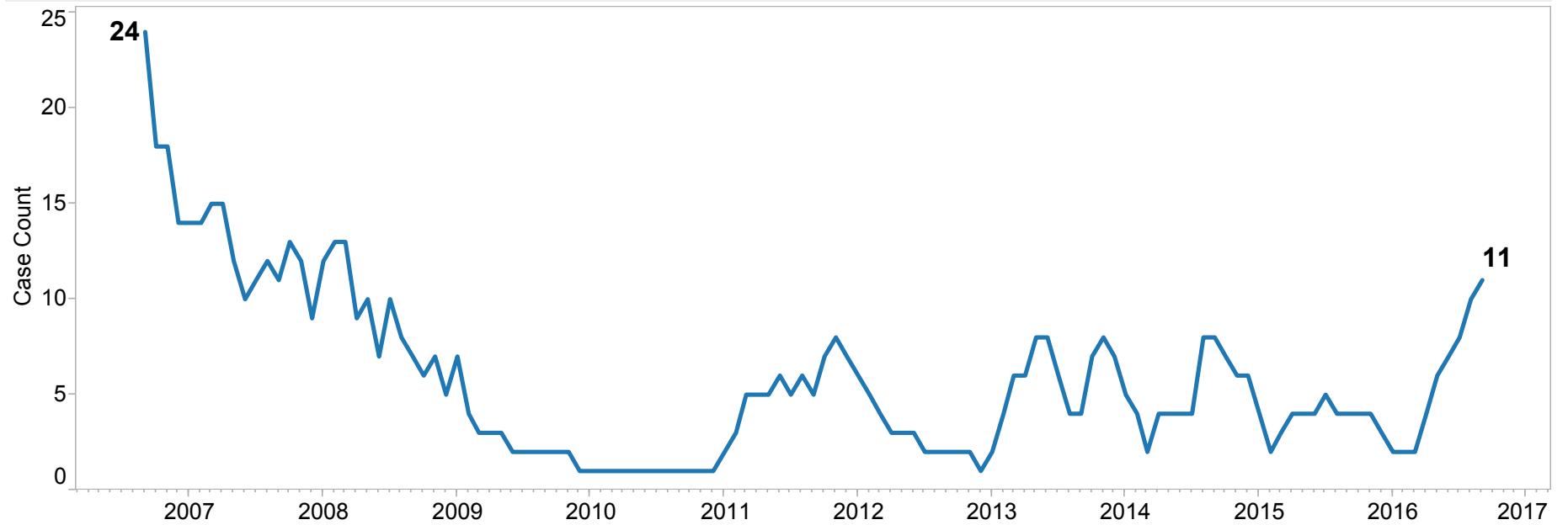

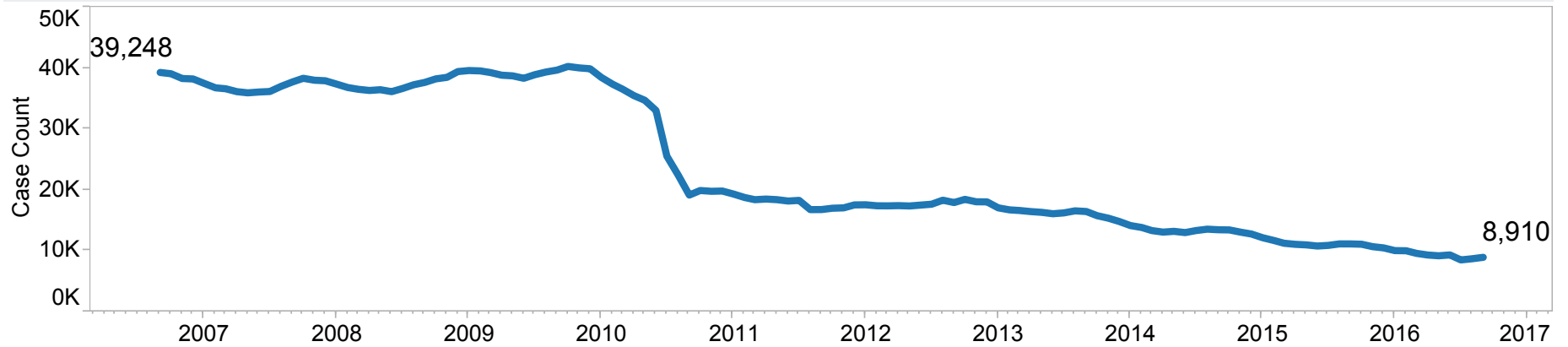
Tuberculosis Control

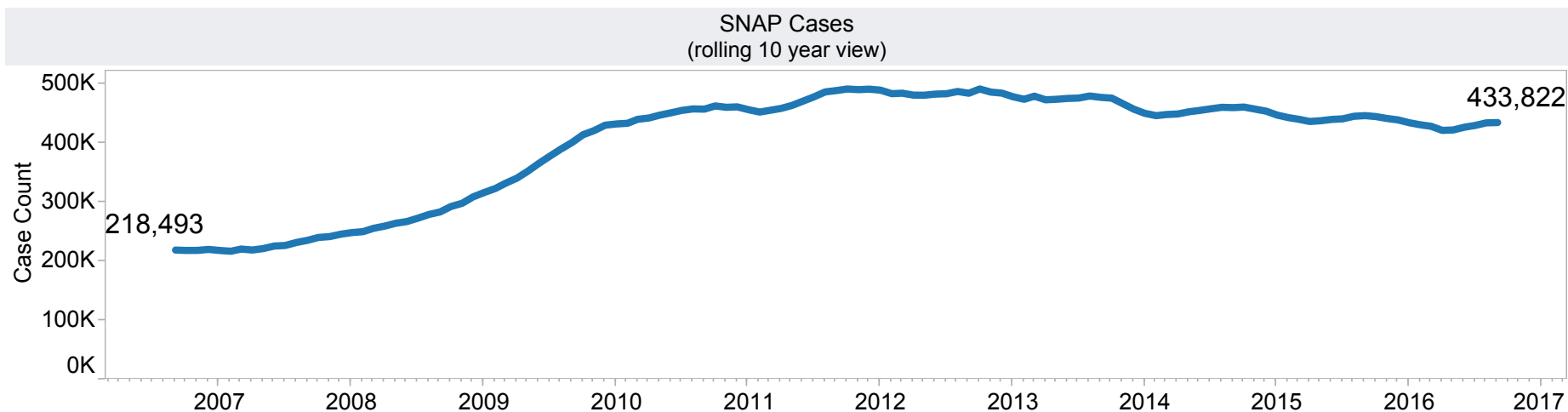
