## **UPDATED GUIDANCE FOR CONGREGATE SETTINGS**

On Thursday, January 6, 2022, DDD updated its <u>COVID-19 Guidance for Congregate Settings and Direct Care Workers</u> guidance document available on the <u>Actions Related to COVID-19</u> web page. The new guidance aligns with recent updates from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) related to COVID-19 vaccine booster shots for individuals age 12-15 as well as additional information related to vaccines and wearing face coverings during transportation.
