On November 30, 2024, in accordance with A.A.C. R 2103(A), the Division posted the list of services open for solicitation beginning January 1, 2025 under RFQVA DDD-2024. The services open for solicitation beginning January 1, 2025 and the areas where the service need is anticipated, are listed below:

Note: Not all services identified in the Qualified Vendor Agreement are included in the solicitation. As noted, the solicitation Request for Qualified Vendor Applications (RFQVA) DDD-2024 includes only the services posted on November 30, 2024.

On January 1, 2025, the Division began accepting applications from prospective vendors to become Qualified Vendors and amendments to add services from existing Qualified Vendors for RFQVA DDD-2024. Due to a technical issue, the Contract Administration System (CAS), which processes the applications, allowed applications to be started which included services not open for solicitation and for which there is currently no need. The technical error was identified and corrected on January 2, 2025.

The Division will communicate next steps individually to the existing Qualified Vendors who submitted an amendment to add a service not being solicited, and with prospective vendors who requested to add a service to their application for which the Division is not soliciting.
