NEW POLICIES

AdSS Medical Policy Manual 530 Member Transfers Between Facilities

This policy was developed to establish the requirements for the Administrative Services Subcontractors (AdSS) regarding Division of Developmental Disabilities (Division) member transfers between facilities to include:

- Created guidelines for the coordination of activities and data sharing when a member transitions between facilities.
- Established the criteria requirements when a member transfers between inpatient hospital facilities following emergency hospitalization
- Established the criteria requirements when a member transfers to a lower level of care facility.
- Established the criteria requirements when a member transfers to a higher level of care facility.

REVISED POLICIES

<u>Division Medical Policy Manual 510 Primary Care Providers</u>

This policy has been revised to align with AMPM 510. Revisions include:

- Updated definitions.
- Added a statement for monitoring and adjusting behavioral health medication as specified in AMPM 310-V for prior authorizations for the antipsychotic class of medications.
- Added a statement for the Division to require coordination and collaboration with behavioral health providers.
- Updated the requirement for PCPs in their care coordination role to serve as a referral agent for specialty and referral treatment, and services for physical or behavioral health services as needed for members
- Added additional services PCPs are required to coordinate following medical care.
- Removed the section for Maintenance of the Member medical records.
- Formatted to align with current Policy standards.

AdSS Medial Policy Manual 510 Primary Care Providers

This policy has been revised to align with AMPM 510. Revisions include:

- Updated definitions.
- Added a statement for monitoring and adjusting behavioral health medication as specified in AMPM 310-V for prior authorizations for the antipsychotic class of medications.
- Added a statement for the AdSS to coordinate and collaborate with behavioral health providers
- Added additional services PCPs are required to coordinate following medical care.
- Removed the section for Maintenance of the Member medical records.
- Added a statement for the AdSS maintaining a current file of Member PCP assignments and accurate tracking of PCP assignments to facilitate continuity of care, control utilization, and obtain encounter data.
- Formatted to align with current Policy standards.

Division Medical Policy Manual 530 Member Transfers Between Facilities

This policy has been revised to align with AMPM 530. Revisions include:

- Added Level of life support for transportation orders between inpatient hospital facilities following emergency hospitalization.
- Added criteria when a member transfers to a higher level of care facility
- Added a section for AdSS oversight and monitoring.
- Formatted to align with current Policy standards.
