DDD CENTRAL REGISTRY TRANSITION TO DCS

Beginning Friday, June 3, 2022, the Division of Developmental Disabilities (DDD) will transfer the processing of all Central Registry checks to the Department of Child Safety (DCS), pursuant to A.R.S. §8-804. On June 3, 2022, all Central Registry requests will need to be emailed directly to DCS at DESCANRegistry@azdcs.gov. For submission details, please see https://dcs.az.gov/resource/request-dcs-information.

During the transition from its former Central Registry system, DCS revised the list of Disqualifying Acts; for details, please see https://dcs.az.gov/sites/default/files/DCS-Forms/CSO-3037_0.pdf. Although the list was modified, individuals who do not clear this check may still be eligible to apply to the Board of Fingerprinting for a central registry exception, pursuant to A.R.S. §41-619.57. This DCS Central Registry Request Submissionguidance outlines the steps Qualified Vendors and Providers will need to follow in submitting applicants for Central Registry checks.
