Yesterday, the state Legislature passed House Bill 2945 which was [signed into law by Governor Hobbs](#). This provides the supplemental funding needed to fund the DDD program through the end of this fiscal year. This avoids gaps in funding this fiscal year and will allow vendors to continue providing services and billing as they normally would to receive payment for those claims.

The Division recognizes how challenging the past several weeks have been and sincerely appreciates your steadfast commitment to the people we serve in a time of uncertainty. Thank you for everything you do to support DDD members, their families, and others who are impacted by this program.

As a reminder, the claims payment processing changes are still in effect and will be the standard moving forward. A [vendor announcement](#) was sent on Wednesday which provides further clarification to the process as well as a short FAQ.
