DDD CENTRAL REGISTRY TRANSITION TO DCS REMINDER

As <u>communicated</u> on April 20, 2022, effective Friday, June 3, 2022 the Division of Developmental Disabilities (DDD) transferred the processing of all Central Registry checks to the Department of Child Safety (DCS), pursuant to A.R.S. §8-804. All Central Registry requests need to be emailed directly to DCS at <u>DESCANRegistryChecks@azdcs.gov</u>. For submission details, please see https://dcs.az.gov/resource/request-dcs-information.

During the transition from its former Central Registry system, DCS revised the list of Disqualifying Acts; for details, please see https://dcs.az.gov/sites/default/files/DCS-Forms/CSO-3037_0.pdf. Although the list was modified, individuals who do not clear this check may still be eligible to apply to the Board of Fingerprinting for a central registry exception, pursuant to A.R.S. §41-619.57. This DCS Central Registry Request Submission guidance outlines the steps Qualified Vendors and Providers will need to follow in submitting applicants for Central Registry checks.
