## New Arizona Department of Public Safety Fingerprint Vendor

Individuals who provide services to DDD members are required to obtain and maintain a level 1 Fingerprint Clearance Card. The Arizona Department of Public Safety (AZDPS) has changed vendors for fingerprinting services, effective June 1, 2020. ## Updated Guidance for Positive COVID-19 Reporting and Technical Assistance

The Division has updated the <u>guidance previously made available</u> regarding vendor responsibilities and the process to report members and employees who test positive for COVID-19.

The updates were made in the "Negotiated Rates" section. For vendors providing services that do not use a habilitation matrix, the guidance has not changed from the June 11, 2020, update. The guidance has been updated to include the submission of a temporary COVID-19 habilitation matrix per Division Provider Policy Manual Chapter 52 once DDD Health Care Services has confirmed a member has tested positive for COVID-19 for vendors supporting members in a group home or in their own home with a daily rate for "Habilitation Individually Designed Living" with a habilitation matrix.
