REVISED PROCUREMENT NOTICE - EXTENDED IMPLEMENTA-TION AND APPLICATION DATES FOR RFQVA DDD-2024: Applications to be Accepted if Submitted by June 3, 2024 at 11:59 PM

This updates the Procurement Notice sent on April 16, 2024. Please read it in its entirety. In order to ensure that members continue to receive access to the Home and Community-Based (HCBS) services they need, the Division of Developmental Disabilities (DDD/Division) is sharing the following: DDD extended the implementation date of DDD RFQVA 2024 to January 1, 2025. This extension allows for more time to process the applications it has received and minimize any potential disruption to service delivery for members. This notice does not affect those Qualified Vendors who have already submitted their applications; there is no need to re-submit.

As a result of the decision to extend the implementation date to January 1, 2025, DDD extended the application due date. DDD has reviewed its procurement notices and the information posted to its webpage and determined that it will process all applications received by 11:59 p.m. on June 3, 2024.

New policy attestations will not be required for Qualified Vendors who have already submitted their applications. This communication will serve as the record for the amended expectation for all Qualified Vendors regarding their policies. Additionally, the initiation of minimum wage requirements for Group Supported Employment (GSE) shall align with the new contract implementation date of January 1, 2025.

Lastly, the Division accepts Central Registry background checks completed between June 30, 2023 and December 31, 2024. Staff that had checks completed prior to June 30, 2023 will require a new check to be completed. The Division anticipates it will post the services that will be solicited under RFQVA DDD-2024 on its website no later than December 1, 2024. Resources including FAQ and technical assistance documents continue to be available on the Division's Project Page.
