ALT EVV LIVE-IN CAREGIVER SPECIFICATIONS WEBINAR NOW AVAILABLE

This communication is intended for provider agencies subject to Electronic Visit Verification (EVV) requirements and EVV vendors. Please read this entire communication for the most up-to-date information on EVV compliance. This communication presents a number of significant EVV updates. AHCCCS understands that providers and vendors may have questions that we may not be able to answer at this time. It was important for us, however, to share with you what we do know at this point in time while maintaining our commitment to continue to provide ongoing updates and a number of tools and resources to support understanding and engagement.

As a reminder, AHCCCS is requiring all provider agencies to identify direct care workers who are live-in caregivers. The information will be used to monitor compliance with the 40 hour weekly and the single agency limitations for the Parents as Paid Caregiver service model as well as support overall data collection for workforce development planning and monitoring.

AHCCCS has posted the recorded webinar held on July 9, 2025 to answer questions about the technical specifications and business requirements on the [EVV webpage](#). **Sandata is currently ready and able to accept this data from alternate vendors. Alternate vendors are expected to have the changes in place and begin submitting the live-in caregiver data to Sandata during the first quarter of the state fiscal year (July 1, 2025 - September 30, 2025). This means the development work must be completed, providers are inputting the data and the data is being transmitted to Sandata. AHCCCS will be closely monitoring progress and compliance of the data by provider agencies.**

It is important to note that AHCCCS plans to maintain the same requirements (including those reflected in the update noted above) when vendors are required to submit data directly to the AHCCCS EVV aggregator beginning October 1, 2025.
