



# REQUIRED CLAIMS MODIFIERS AND EVV INDICATORS FOR PARENTS AS PAID CAREGIVERS

Target Audience - Qualified Vendors and Providers

The Division is required to comply with all state and federal laws and rules. On April 25, 2025, Governor Hobbs signed [House Bill \(HB\) 2945](#) into law. One part of the legislation requires that beginning October 1, 2025, the Division requires a unique modifier that delineates that a Parent is providing the Attendant Care and Habilitation, hourly on claim submissions. A Parent is defined as “Parents who have formal physical and/or legal custody of their minor child including guardians of minor children.” Qualified Vendors will be required to add the “CG” modifier to claims they submit for which the service was provided to a minor child by a paid Parent caregiver, with dates of service 10/1/2025 or later. The “CG” modifier is only required on claims submitted for DDD members. Vendors who may also provide services to members in the Elderly Physically Disabled (EPD) program will not be required to use this modifier. This modifier is in addition to the U4 or U5, therefore 2 modifiers will be used on claims submitted by a Qualified Vendor for care provided by a Parent.

Additionally, Electronic Visit Verification (EVV) data will be the data source used by DES and AHCCCS for monitoring compliance with the single agency and 40 hour per member limit requirements in HB2945. Qualified Vendors must ensure they implement use of the live-in caregiver data elements in EVV no later than October 1, 2025 as outlined in the [Alt EVV Live-In Caregiver Specifications Webinar Now Available communication](#) sent by DDD on July 17, 2025.
