NEW POLICIES

<u>Division Medical Policy Manual 310-C Breast Reconstruction After Mastectomy</u>

This policy has been developed to align with the AMPM 310-C. This new policy describes covered breast reconstruction surgery services following a mastectomy for DDD members who are eligible for ALTCS.

AdSS Medical Policy Manual 310-C Breast Reconstruction After Mastectomy

This policy has been developed to align with the AMPM 310-C. This is a new policy that describes covered breast reconstruction surgery services following a mastectomy for ALTCS members. This policy applies to DDD's Administrative Services Subcontractors (AdSS).

Eligibility Policy Manual 201 Applicants with Down Syndrome

Division Eligibility Manual Policy 201, Applicants With Down Syndrome has been developed pursuant to HB2113. This policy does the following:

- Expands eligibility for Division services to include Down Syndrome as the Division's fifth qualifying diagnosis.
- Facilitates the addition of Down Syndrome to all current Division Eligibility policies regarding diagnoses.
- Describes diagnostic information needed to determine eligibility for Division services.

Division Medical Policy Manual 310-M Immunizations

This policy has been revised to reflect the recent updates as follows:

Division Medical Policy Manual 1240-D Emergency Alert System

- Clarifies the criteria that must be met for Members to receive and use Emergency Alert System (EAS) equipment.
- Specifies the Administrative Services Subcontractor's (AdSS) responsibility to provide EAS for Members enrolled in DDD Health Plans.
- Specifies AHCCCS' responsibility to provide EAS for Members enrolled in the Tribal Health Program.
- Adds the Support Coordinator's role in coordinating EAS for Members.
- Updates the document to align with the DDD's policy formatting standards.

Provider Policy Manual Chapter 2 Provider Responsibilities and Expectations

This policy has been revised to reflect the recent updates as follows:

- The phrase "continuous care more than 16 hour per day" was replaced with "care for more than 16 hours in a 24-hour period."
- Links to websites were removed.

<u>Division Operations Policy Manual 404 Contractor Website and Member Information</u>

This policy has been revised to reflect the recent updates as follows:

- Updates were made to reflect AHCCCS updates to ACOM 404 regarding font size, including removal of references to 18 point font size for readability.
- Formatting changes were made to reflect current standards.
- Updates made to reflect current AHCCCS requirements for how we have member information reviewed and what is required to be on our website.
- Requirements for the bi-annual newsletter were updated to reflect current requirements.

AdSS Operations Policy Manual 404 Contractor Website and Member Information

- This policy has been updated to reflect changes made to ACOM 404 regarding font size on materials produced for communicating information to members.
- Changes also reflect current requirements for how Member Information Materials are reviewed.
