DDAC Update Taylor Pike

Discussion	Taylor Pike informed the committee of the topics discussed at the Developmental Disabilities Advisory Council (DDAC) meeting.
	The Developmental Disabilities Advisory Council is a group of volunteers appointed to serve as an advisory council to the Division, specifically the DDD Assistant Director who attends the meetings.

DDAC members serve on a subcommittee and approve or disapprove Client Services Trust Fund (CTSF) applications. CTSF is a one time fund to provide assistance for members and their families. This September, a total of 79 applications were received and the committee approved 11. Applications were disapproved due to multiple item requests, incomplete applications and financial statements showing residual funds.

Taylor explained the vendor call process to obtain services and proposed changes to policy 3003, Selection of Vendor. Individuals can provide comments and opinions on proposed policy changes via email at DDDPolicy@azdes.gov.

Renaldo Fowler with Arizona Center for Disability Law (ACDL) spoke about members' voting rights. Individuals with limited guardianship can vote. People with disabilities have a right to vote, that right has to be taken from them.
