New DDD Health Plans Are Effective October 1, 2019

The Division of Developmental Disabilities, through a contract with the Arizona Health Care Cost Containment System (AHCCCS), offers health care coverage to members who are eligible for the Arizona Long Term Care System (ALTCSS). This coverage includes physical health services, behavioral health services, Children's Rehabilitative Services (CRS) and limited Long Term Services and Supports (LTSS). Mercy Care and UnitedHealthcare Community Plan (UHCCP) will provide the new DDD Health Plans effective October 1, 2019.

Eligible members will receive a letter from DDD no later than September 20, with details about their DDD Health Plan. This letter will include the DDD Health Plan's name and contact information. If you have a question about your DDD Health Plan, please contact your Support Coordinator or Member Services at 1-844-770-9500 ext. 7. Eligible members will also receive information directly from their DDD Health Plan.

Get Your Flu Shot

As summer ends and we look forward to cooler temperatures it is time to think about getting your flu shot. Flu season starts in the Fall and can last through May. The Arizona Department of Health Services (ADHS) recommends a flu vaccination as the best way to prevent getting the flu. AHCCCS members under the age of 19 must receive the flu vaccine from a Vaccine for Children provider. Contact your PCP to learn when the vaccine will be available.
