

What is Community Navigation?

Resource Navigation is leading customers to the right resource at the right time

"No wrong door, no wrong person" approach



Community Navigation Goals

Increase client awareness

Expand access to critical assistance programs

Treat people like people - not numbers



Why is Community Navigation Important?

Inequitable access to public programs

Barriers to access for historically underserved communities

Barriers include lack of transportation, lack of child care, inability to access local offices during business hours, etc

Individuals with limited internet access and who struggle to understand requirements of public programs are left to struggle.



Tribal Nation & ADES Collaboration

How can Tribal Nations collaborate with ADES to deliver services, such as LIHEAP, to their members?

LIHEAP Tribal Nation Partnerships

These include:

- Tribal Nation Administered
- ADES Contracted
- ADES Administered

COORDINATION

the act of **making parts** of something, groups of people, working together in an efficient and organized way

COOPERATION

the fact of **doing something together** or of working together towards a shared aim

COLLABORATION

the act of working with another person or group of people to **create or produce something**

Tribal Nation Administered Programs

- The Tribal Nation receives funding for, and administers its own Program
- ADES may assist the Tribal nation with program administration, by:
 - Sharing best practices, policies, and forms
 - Providing technical assistance with program administration, reporting and monitoring
 - Sharing or collaborating in training opportunities
- Let us be a resource for you!

ADES Contracted / Administered

ADES Contracted:

- The Tribal Nation receives Program funding, but contracts with ADES to administer its Program on behalf of the Tribal Nation.
- The Tribal Nation sets Program guidelines (eligibility, benefits, etc.), ADES administers to Tribal Nation members per contract.

ADES Administered:

- The Tribal Nation does not receive or has exhausted its Program funding, and Tribal Nation members are served by ADES (subject to funding and specific program criteria)
- ADES may assist the Tribal Nation with service delivery through community navigation, by providing training and technical assistance to a local Program coordinator or formal community navigator
- As a general rule: Members of Tribal Nations are *always* eligible for ADES benefits if they are not already eligible to receive the same benefit through their Tribal Nation.

LIHEAP Tribal Nation Partnerships - Summary

Regardless of the type of partnership, we are here as a resource and partner for our Tribal Nations

- Tribal Nation Administered
 - Information sharing and technical assistance for program administration
- ADES Contracted
 - Administration of program on behalf of Tribal Nation
- ADES Administered
 - Community navigation training and assistance for local access to Tribal Nations
