WIOA State Plan

- Outlines the State's four-year strategy for the workforce development system
- Requires planning across all core programs to ensure integrated service delivery:
 - Adult program (Title I of WIOA)
 - Dislocated Worker program (Title I of WIOA)
 - Youth program (Title Iof WIOA)
 - Adult Education and Family Literacy Act program (Title II)
 - Wagner-Peyser Act Employment Service program (Title III)
 - Vocational Rehabilitation program (IV)



WIOA State Plan Components

Strategic Planning Elements:

- includes economic condition, workforce characteristics, and workforce development activities analysis.
- required vision, goals, and strategies for the State's workforce system.

Operational Planning Elements

- identifies the efforts to support the State's strategic vision and goals
- outlines necessary infrastructure, policies, and activities needed to achieve goals
