TOPIC: AHCCCS Requirements for Direct Care Worker (DCW) Training and Testing Program

Target Audience - Qualified Vendors of Attendant Care and Homemaker Services

This information is intended for Qualified Vendor agencies that provide Attendant Care (ATC) and Homemaker (HSK) services and/or are approved Direct Care Worker (DCW) training and testing sites.

Did you know....?

- Qualified Vendor agencies that use direct care workers to provide ATC and/or HSK services are required to incorporate the DCW database into everyday business practices.
- All ATC and HSK direct care workers must be entered into the DCW database within 30 days of hire, suspension, or termination by your agency.
- Qualified Vendors must maintain a listing of all individuals who are authorized to use the database and report immediately to AHCCCS any changes to the list.
- All ATC and HSK direct care workers must complete training through an AHCCCS-approved DCW training and testing program within 90 days of hire.
- Six hours of continuing education is required annually for ATC and HSK direct care workers. Specific documentation of the training to be included in direct care worker's employee file.
