Comment: During Federal Fiscal Year 2017, the Lead Agency (LA) supported local programs to improve the implementation of dispute resolution procedures through targeted technical assistance about how to support families to understand their procedural safeguards and dispute resolution options. Additionally, contract action was taken against programs with multiple written, signed complaints that resulted in findings of noncompliance. This two pronged approach of focused technical assistance and contract action resulted in a decrease in the overall number of written, signed complaints and in findings of noncompliance at the local program level. Furthermore, the LA received extensive support from national technical assistance (TA) centers including the Early Childhood Technical Assistance Center (ECTA), The IDEA Data Center (IDC), The Center for IDEA Early Childhood Data Systems (DaSY), and the National Center for Systemic Improvement (NCSI), through monthly phone calls.
