

Arizona Early Intervention Program (AzEIP)

Mission

Early intervention builds upon and provides supports and resources to assist family members and caregivers to enhance children's learning and development through everyday learning opportunities.



What is AzEIP

- Statewide interagency
- Provides services to infants and toddler birth through two years of age
- Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) Part C
- Team Based Early Intervention Services

AzEIP serves an average of 16,000 infants & toddlers yearly!

Evaluation and Eligibility

Arizona Early Intervention Program (AzEIP)

- 50% developmental delay in one or more developmental domains
- Established Condition (Medical records with a diagnosis)
- Informed Clinical Opinion

Arizona State Schools for the Deaf and the Blind (ASDB)

- Unilateral or bilateral vision loss
- Unilateral or bilateral hearing loss

Division of Developmental Disabilities (DDD)

- Cerebral Palsy
- Epilepsy
- Autism
- Cognitive/Intellectual
- Down Syndrome
- At risk for any of the above*
