- Submissions must be the child's original artwork, and can include: poetry, photography, paintings, drawings, sculptures, music, video, arts and crafts... any type of art!
- Only one entry will be accepted per child, and entries may not contain profanity or inappropriate content.
- Nine winners will be chosen: three winners from each age category (5-8, 9-13, and 14-18).
- Accepted formats include: Word document, .pdf, .jpeg, .png, .mp3, .mp4, or URL to a webpage.
