Here in the Division of Developmental Disabilities (DDD) we are privileged to provide access to acute services (for physical health needs); behavioral services; Children's Rehabilitative Services (for children with chronic conditions) and therapies to address developmental disabilities. For many of our members, these services are funded with assistance from the Arizona Health Care Cost Containment System (AHCCCS).



As our partners at AHCCCS move toward an integrated health plan, we are doing the same. DDD is working on a Request for Proposal for an integrated plan our members can utilize for the most comprehensive care that covers all their needs. Here is a timeline. We'll keep you updated on our progress.
