12 13	This policy defines the processes used to accept and process
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14	applications for a Children's Rehabilitative Services (CRS)
15	designation and delineates the responsibility for coverage and
16	payment of CRS conditions, as well as other services that are the
17	responsibility of the Division of Developmental Disabilities
18	(Division).

21	1. "Active Treatment" means a current need for treatment of
22	the CRS qualifying condition(s) or it is anticipated that
	the CKS qualifying condition(s) of it is underpated that
23	treatment or evaluation for continuing treatment of the
24	CRS qualifying condition(s) will be needed within the next



25		18 months from the last date of service for treatment of
26	<u>i</u>	any CRS qualifying condition (A.A.C. R9-22-1301).
27	2.	"Children's Rehabilitative Services" or "CRS" means a
28	1	program that provides covered medical services and
29	!	covered support services in accordance with A.A.C. R9-
30	2	22-1303 and A.R.S. § 36-2912.
31	<u>3.</u>	"CRS Application" means a submitted form with additional
32	!	documentation required by the Arizona Health Care Cost
33	9	Containment System (AHCCCS) Division of Member and
34	1	Provider Services (DMPS) in order to make a
35	9	determination whether an AHCCCS member is medically
36	2	eligible for a CRS Designation.
37	4.	"CRS Condition" means pursuant to A.R.S. § 36-2912,
38	!	those covered conditions that are medically disabling or
39	ÇX	potentially disabling and which qualify for CRS medical
40	(0)	eligibility as specified in A.A.C. R9-22-1303.
41	5.	"Member" means the same as "Client" as defined in A.R.S.
42	•	§ 36-551.



43	<u>6.</u>	"Provider" means any individual or entity contracted with the
44		AdSS that is engaged in the delivery of services, or ordering or
45		referring for those services, and is legally authorized to do so by
46		the State.
47	<u>7.</u>	"Responsible Person" means the parent or quardian of a
48		minor with a developmental disability, the guardian of an
49		adult with a developmental disability or an adult with a
50		developmental disability who is a member or an applicant
51		for whom no guardian has been appointed.

60	A. RESI	ONSIBILITIES FOR CRS SERVICES



61	1.	The Division shall cover services to Members under the age of 21
62		who have been confirmed to have a CRS condition requiring
63		active treatment, as described in A.A.C. R9-22-1303.
64	<u>2.</u>	The Division shall require the AdSS to submit medical
65		documentation to AHCCCS upon request to assist with review of
66		a current CRS designation.
67	<u>3.</u>	The Division shall allow the Member to use their private
68		insurance network or Medicare Providers to obtain health care
69		services, including those for treatment of the CRS conditions.
70	4.	The Division shall refer to AMPM Operations Manual Policies 201
71		and 434 for responsibilities for payment of services for treatment
72		of the CRS condition(s), when a Member uses private insurance
73		or Medicare.
74	B. APP	LICATION
75	1.	The Division shall require a CRS application be submitted to the
76	10	AHCCCS DMPS for a medical eligibility determination described in
77	0,	A.A.C. R9-22 Article 13.
78	<u>2.</u>	The Division shall require a completed CRS application be
79		submitted by:

83	<u>3.</u> T	e Division shall require the following upon submission of the
84	<u>C</u>	mpleted CRS application to DMPS:
85	<u>a</u>	Notify the Member or Responsible Person in writing that an
86		application for a CRS designation has been submitted on
87		the Member's behalf; and
88	<u>b</u>	Inform the Member or Responsible Person that the Member
89		will be referred to a specialist for an evaluation of the CRS
90		condition, if needed.
91	<u>4. T</u>	ne Division shall require the following documentation with
92	<u>S</u>	bmission of the CRS application:
93	<u>a</u>	Documentation from a specialist who diagnosed the
94	çX	Member, stating the Member's diagnosis and the need for
95	101	active treatment; and
96	<u>b</u>	Diagnostic testing results that support the medical
97	▼	diagnosis.



The Division shall require that the information provided by DMPS 98 is made available to the appropriate areas and staff within its 99 organization who may need the information. 100 **MEMBERS TURNING 21** 101 The Division shall require Members are notified at least 90 days 102 prior to a Member with a CRS designation turning 21 years of 103 age that their CRS designation ends upon their 21st birthday. 104 The Division shall require specialty services related to the 105 Member's CRS Condition are completed, as clinically appropriate, 106 prior to the Member's 21st birthday. 107 The Division shall require health care service delivery and care 108 coordination is provided, regardless of the Member's CRS 109 designation ending. 110 MONITORING OF THE CRS DESIGNATION 111 The Division shall verify ongoing Active Treatment status of the 112 CRS Condition as described in A.A.C. R9-22-1305. 113 The Division shall require notification to AHCCCS of Members 114 under the age of 21 with a CRS Condition who are no longer 115 116 requiring active treatment for the CRS qualifying condition,



117			including medical records indicating treatment has been
118			completed.
119		<u>3.</u>	The Division shall require that Completed Treatment Reports are
120			transmitted to AHCCCS, as specified in contract for Members
121			with a CRS designation who have completed treatment.
122		4.	The Division shall require CRS Completed Treatment Reports be
123			submitted to the Division by the AdSS monthly as required:
124			a. For Members with a CRS designation who have completed
125			treatment, or
126			b. If DMPS determines that a CRS Member is no longer
127			medically eligible for CRS and ends the CRS designation.
128	<u>E.</u>	AdS	S OVERSIGHT AND MONITORING
129		The	Division shall refer to Division Operations 438 for monitoring and
130		over	sight responsibilities of the AdSS.
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
