



Appeals Board Meeting Minutes

Telephonic Meeting

Tuesday, August 5, 2025

The Appeals Board conducts final agency review of Unemployment Insurance and Public Assistance cases that are appealed following an Office of Appeals hearing and decision and considers Unemployment Insurance claims filed during a work stoppage or lock-out arising from a labor dispute. Appeals from the Board's decisions are to the Arizona Court of Appeals. The Appeals Board has original jurisdiction to conduct hearings on appeals from a decision of the Unemployment Insurance Tax Section regarding an Employer's liability for contributions to the Unemployment Insurance fund. Appeals from the Board's decisions are made to the Arizona Tax Court.
